The Minnesota TeleCenter, Twin Cities Public Television's new state-of-the-art broadcasting facility, celebrates its grand opening in August 1989. The \$10.7 million dollar 82,000 square-foot TeleCenter is the new home of KTCA/TV Channel 2 and KTCI/TV Channel 17, featuring three studios, telecommunications capabilities, a 400 percent increase in set construction and storage space of the old site, administrative offices, and vertical expansion potential. In addition to bringing the entire staff under one roof for the first time in a decade, The TeleCenter will allow the station to expand its local and national programming. KTCA is nationally recognized for its innovative and quality programming, including Emmy Award-winning EWTON'S APPLE and ALIVE FROM OFF CENTER.
