June 5th 1839 Do 1 bushel of wheat

AD 1839 Dr Williamson &
Mr Renville - Changed Receipts
settled all square in the Autumn

June 1840 Mr. Kirker &
I sheared eight of Mr Ken
villes sheep from which we
got seventeen $8\frac{1}{4}$ lbs of good
picked wool & about 3 lbs
hip locks good for nothing that
I know of
