
## "THE MACY PATCH"

THE COLORED PATCH ON THE COVER OF THIS FOLDER IS THE OFFICIAL INSIGNIA OF THE UNITED STATES MILITARY ASSISTANCE COMMAND, VIETNAM.

DESCRIPTION: THE INSIGNIA CONSISTS OF A SWORD WITH YELLOW HILT AND WHITE BLADE POINT TO TOP BETWEEN TWO SEGMENTS OF A YELLOW ARCHED EMBATTLED FESS AND A RED SHIELD THREE INCHES OVERALL IN HEIGHT, ALL WITHIN A 1/8 INCH YELLOW BORDER.

SYMBOLISM OF INSIGNIA: YELLOW AND RED ARE THE VIETNAM COLORS.

THE RED GROUND ALLUDES TO THE INFILTRATION AND OPPRESSION FROM BEYOND THE EMBATTLED WALL (I.E. THE GREAT WALL OF CHINA). THE OPENING IN THE "WALL" THROUGH WHICH THIS NFILTRATION AND OPPRESSION FLOW IS BLOCKED BY THE SWORD REPRESENTING UNITED STATES WILLTARY AID AND SUPPORT. THE "WALL" IS ARCHED AND THE SWORD POINTED UPWARD IN REFERENCE TO THE OFFENSIVE ACTION PUSHING THE AGGRESSOR BACK.
