PART OF THE WORK OF SUSTAINING HEALTHY
RELATIONS IS LIKE PUTTING THE FINISHING TOUCHES
ON A 2,000-PIECE PUZZLE. SOMETIMES IT SEEMS LIKE
WE SPEND MOST OF OUR TIME LOOKING FOR LOST
PIECES -- AND WE END UP ASSUMING THAT SOMEONE
IS HIDING THEM.

THE PUZZLE IS NEVER QUITE FINISHED, OF COURSE. ADDING TO THE CHALLENGE, SOME OF THE KEY PIECES KEEP MOVING AROUND. (I HAVE FOUND AT THE EMBASSY THAT PERSONNEL CHANGES ARE A TACTIC TO CONFUSE OTHERWISE SURE-FOOTED AMBASSADORS. JUST WHEN THINGS GET STARTED, PEOPLE ARE TRANSFERRED ELSEWHERE.)

IN THE GRAND SCHEME OF THIS CRUCIAL
RELATIONSHIP, I AM SURE THAT BILL CLARK WILL
PULL A NUMBER OF PIECES INTO PLACE AND HOLD
THEM THERE, SO IT IS GOOD TO HAVE HIM AT THE HELM
OF THE JAPAN SOCIETY.

IT DOES INDEED TAKE A LOT OF PEOPLE TO PLAY
THE VARIOUS PARTS OF THIS SYMPHONY. I COMMEND
YOU ALL FOR YOUR ROLE, AND WE LOOK TO MAESTRO
CLARK TO ENSURE CONTINUED HARMONY.
