My dear Mr Hill

Mr Kennedy has told me
fully of his interview with you
& Mr Morgan last week in
New York and of the decision
arrived at to deposit with him
JP Morgan & the Stocks of the
Northern Pacific & Northern R.R.
for the purposes spoken of when
last I had the pleasure of
seeing you.

I can arrange
to deposit the Six thousand
shares of Common N. Pacific R.R.
Stock I hold without delay &
so much of my Northern R.R.
which I hold as is free but
part is now used (for the use of
commitments already made) as

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Collateral; I have written to my
Sister to give me full particulars
as soon as I hear there will
write to them at the request of Dr. Depont
she starts as soon as I can have
my safe Depont Box open, which by
my own return, or that of my son
who is also now absent for a few
days vacation, but will return before
September 1st. I think this will
be in ample time.

Mr Kennedy also told me of the
purchase of the Pacific Common
for the purpose of holding Control of
the Co. that you hoped your
friends would like some of it -
as this would be advantageous that
he (Mr Kennedy) had taken from

be only too glad to take a liberal
line also, but regret that I am
not in a position to do so now, as
my means are locked up in the
R.R. we are building in Arizona,
& on these difficulties we cannot
borrow at present, - so I have had
to borrow on other Collaterals - but
of course I desire to do all I
can, under the circumstances,
& on my return to the City
I will arrange to take not
exceed Twenty five thousand
Thanks the price I understand
from Mr Kennedy was fixed at
115% of the Pacific Commod.

are coming to Bar Harbor in your
Yacht; my Wife & I would very
have the pleasure of seeing you
