To provide ample space for this Exhibition in particular, and for other Exhibitions, Mr. George W. Vanderbilt advanced the money necessary to build the beautiful gallery which, on December 30th, was presented by him to the American Fine Arts Society, and which now bears his name.

The profits of the Loan Exhibition are to be applied to the payment of the second mortgage on the property of the American Fine Arts Society; while the proceeds of the Exhibition may not be sufficient to accomplish this result, it is hoped that the amount needed may be completed by additional subscriptions to the Gift Fund of the Society. Mr. Vanderbilt, in making his generous gift, expressed the hope that the citizens of New York would come forward and assist the Fine Arts Society in the retirement of this second mortgage.

The Exhibition will be open from February 13th to about March 15th, 1893.

It is expected, from the scope and variety of the Exhibition, that this will be The Event of the Art World in this city for the coming year.

In the hope of realizing this expectation, the aid of all amateurs and collectors is earnestly requested.

N. B.—All expenses of collecting and returning Works of Art will be borne by the Committee; they will be insured at the owner's valuation, and all possible care will be taken of them during the Exhibition.
