Articles of agreement entered into this 20th day of December A.D. 1871 between William B. Newcomb, Chauncey H. Griggs and James J. Hill all of Saint Paul Minnesota, witnesses;

Whereas the said parties have ^{been} doing business as Co-Partners, under the firm name and style of "Hill, Griggs & Co.", under certain Co-partnership articles signed by them and bearing date the 20th day of August A.D. 1869; and whereas the said firm of "Hill Griggs & Co." afterwards entered into a certain other Co-partnership with one Delbitt C. Kinsey, under certain articles in writing, bearing date the second day of August A.D. 1870, under the firm and style of "Hill, Griggs & Co. R. R. business" for the purpose of carrying on a merchandising and transportation business on the Red River of the north; and whereas the said firm of "Hill, Griggs & Co." afterwards entered into a certain other agreement in writing, bearing date the 20th day of February A.D. 1871, with one Alexander Griggs relating to the ownership & business of a certain Steamboat to be run upon the Red River of the north, in which the said "Hill, Griggs & Co." were to have five sixths interest and the said Griggs one sixths interest; and whereas on the 25th day of

August A.D. 1869 the said James J. Hill, Chauncey W. Griggs & William B. Newcomb & one John A. Armstrong entered into certain Co-partnership articles bearing that date to carry on the wood business at Saint Paul, Saint Anthony, Minneapolis and elsewhere in Minnesota as might be deemed advisable, the said business to be done in the name of "Hill, Griggs & Co." or of "John A. Armstrong" either or both as might be found convenient;

Therefore, in consideration of Twenty One Thousand One Hundred forty nine & 7/100 dollars in hand paid by the said James J. Hill and Chauncey W. Griggs to the said William B. Newcomb, and the receipt whereof the said Newcomb hereby acknowledges, the said Newcomb does hereby bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said James J. Hill and Chauncey W. August A.D. 1869 the said James J. Hill, Chauncey M. Griggs & William B. Newcomb & one John A. Armstrong entered into certain Co-partnership articles bearing that date to carry on the wood business at Saint Paul, Saint Anthony, Minneapolis and elsewhere in Minnesota as might be deemed advisable, the said business to be done in the name of "Hill, Griggs & Co." or of "John A. Armstrong" either or both as might be found convenient;

Therefore, in consideration of Twenty One Thousand One Hundred forty nine & 7/100 dollars in hand paid by the said James J. Hill and Chauncey M. Griggs to the said William B. Newcomb, and the receipt whereof the said Newcomb hereby acknowledges, the said Newcomb does hereby bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said James J. Hill and Chauncey M. Co-partnership assets, property and business of the said copartnership so constituted under the said Articles dated, the 25th day of August 1869 between the said John A. Armstrong, James J. Hill, Chauncy W. Griggs and William B. Newcomb for carrying on the wood business as aforesaid; and also in & to the copartnership assets, property and business of the said firm of "Hill, Griggs & Co. R. R. business" under the said Articles dated August 2nd 1870, between the said "Hill, Griggs & Co" and the said Dewitt C. Kinsey; and also in & to the articles of agreement aforesaid, dated February 20th A.D. 1871, executed between the said "Hill, Griggs & Co." of the one part, and the said Alexander Griggs of the other part & in & to the steamboat & the business & the assets & property therein described, & thenunder existing, also in & to the assets, property & business of a certain special partnership between the said parties under the ~~said~~ firm name of ~~Hill, Griggs & Co~~ "the Saint Paul Brick Company" under articles in writing dated June 26th 1869; and in & to all & every property, personal or real, choses in action, book accounts & notes, belonging to the said firm of "Hill Griggs & Co" under

the ^{agreed} articles of agreement and under each and every of them;

And in consideration of the promises the said
Chauncey H. Griggs & James J. Hill do hereby
promise and agree to and with the said
William B. Newcomb to pay off & discharge
all and singular the debts & liabilities now
outstanding & being against the said firm
of "Hill, Griggs & Co" and against the said
firm of "Hill, Griggs & Co R.R. business"
and against the said firm so constituted
by articles with the said John A. Armstrong
and against the said "Saint Paul Brick
Company" and against the said Steamboat
or growing out of the said Agreement with
the said Alexander Griggs, or the business
done thereunder, and to hold the said
Newcomb forever harmless from the
said debts and liabilities and from
each and every of them.
