All our wines in casks are sent ready for bottling after 10 to 15 days rest, but we advise our customers to allow us to bottle their wines for them.

Our charge for bottling is \$ 30 per Hogshead or \$ 17 per Half Hogshead all found. The Hogshead contains about 300 Bottles, or 600 Half-Bottles. The charge for bottling wines in Half-Bottles is \$ 60 per Hogshead and \$ 34, per Half-Hogshead or 300 Half-Bottles.

Our accounts are payable at 3, 4 or 6 months from date of shipment by cheques direct to us, or by our drafts.

We allow 5 % discount for orders accompanied by remittance.
