My Dear Sir,

I have received cable advice from Mr. Skinner that he has sold £25,000 Pacific Extension 4% bonds at from 87 1/2 to 87 3/4 for settlement of August 12th. I have cabled him to sell £25,000 more at 87 1/2% or better and £25,000 at 88% or better and to report. His instructions are to make cable remittances for all bonds sold as soon as proceeds are received.

I understand that you will be here before this remittance is received, and we will then settle ~~the account~~ as to how the money shall be divided as between your account and the Great Northern. Mr. Skinner has £170,000 of these bonds, of which £74,400 belong to you and the balance to the Great Northern R'y Co.

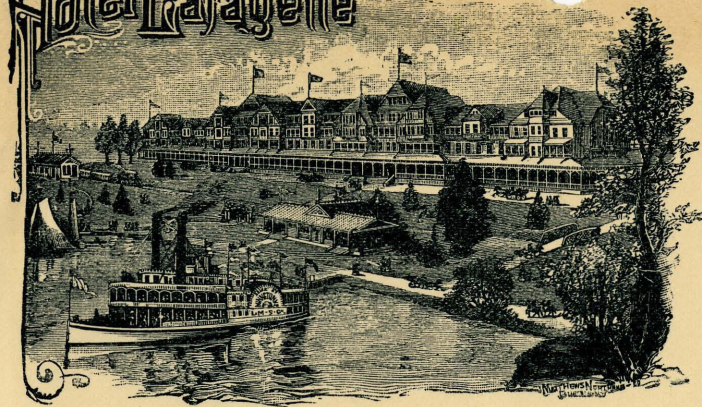

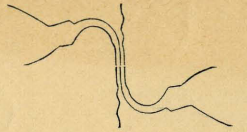
