You have certainly gathered to-

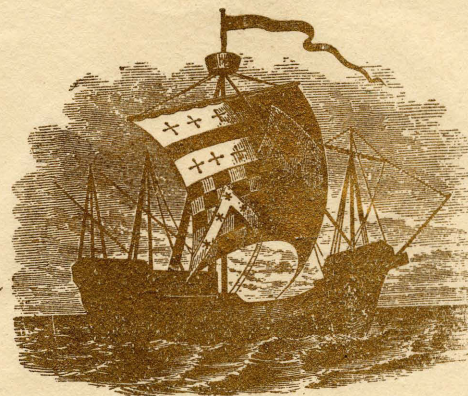


gether a beautiful collection
