

The total amount of the Great Northern Collateral Trust 4% bonds subscribed for by Mr. Hill was \$1,532,850. In disposing of the fraction of \$850. I simply consolidated that fraction with \$150. belonging to myself, and I can give you the numbers of the bonds sold against it.

at the M. S. D. Co's vaults.
