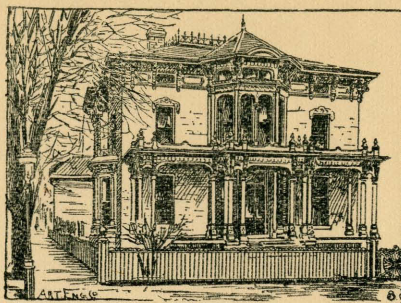


Dear Sir:-
