## ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the PRINCETON & ANOKA RAILROAD COMPANY has made and delivered to me, and caused to be filed in my office, a proposition, which is substantially as follows:

N. B. It is the duty of the Town Clerk or County Auditor receiving this Railroad proposition,—

1st. To note thereon the date of its receipt by him,

2nd. To record the same in the records of his town or county;

3rd. To immediately publish a notice of an election to be held by the legal voters of said county or town at the usual place or places, and at such time, not less than 10 nor more than 20 days from the date of such notices as the Clerk or Auditor, (as the case may be), may designate;

4th. This notice must be given by posting notices in three public places in each election district, at least seven(7) days before the day of election, and must be published twice before such election, by a newspaper in the town in which aid is asked, if there is one, if none then in the newspaper published nearest to such town.

As to county and town elections, see Laws of 1877, Chap. 106, Pages 198—9 and 200.
