[Feb. 5, 1877]

Extract from Sec. 7 of the act of 1887,
incorporating the Minnesota and
Pacific Railroad Company -

"And said Company shall have
power to connect the said railroad
or branches with any other railroad
or branch thereof in this Territory or
State, or in the State of Wisconsin
and to operate the same in connection
with such other railroad or branch
and under such name and
on such terms as may be
agreed upon by and between
said Companies, or to purchase
from any other railroad Company
the whole, or any part of any
railroad or branch railroad owned
by the ^{such} Company"

Act of March 3, 1870

That the First
Division of the St Paul and
Pacific Railroad Company
is hereby authorized to survey
locate and construct a branch
railroad from St Cloud, via
Bank Center, Shakopee and

Alexandria to some point on
the Red River of the North,
to be by said Company de-
signated; Provided that
said Company shall be
bound to carry freight and
passengers upon said proposed
extension upon reasonable
rates -
