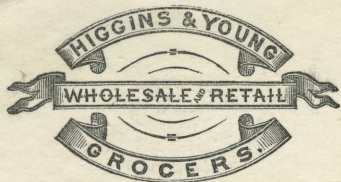
Dear Brother Ed,
