I was rather disappointed to find on my arrival here Mr. K. and yourself both absent. Concluded to go back and come again in about two weeks.

While in the office yesterday a party came in with a Claim in favor of Ashdown for a rebait on Two Cris Coal. Said Mr. Kittson gave him a rate of #10 per ton through from Duluth. Now it was always my understanding that everybody should be charged regular tariff rate in coal (70% per 100 from Duluth) in this way we con------ the coal trade, take it all down in barges in high water at our own convenience, and get #10 per ton on the freight; and make as much as to dabble in little add car load lots. This naturally forces every one who wants coal to come to me, and I will sell it at about cost and tariff frieght (which is as well as they can do unless they get a rebait).

Now that I have about 500 tons of coal on hand if Mr. K. gives a special rate to every man who thinks he wants to do better than purchasing of me, it will ruin me as three mashs. I request you to put this matter in the proper light to Mr. K. and request him to stick to the tariff on coal, and refer all applicants to me;; and I promise not to turn any of the Co's. friends away dissatisfied or charge them unreasonable rates if the matter is left in my hands. I will be down again between the 10th. and 15th. of July.
