I spoke to
M^r Chase about the Government order
for barrel bloss and learnt from him that
the rate of freight would be the same
whether they were shipped separately or
two or more lots in one car. We got some
empty barrels from Rice's Point and also
some from private citizens (thirty nine (39)
in all). This will cover five tons of bloss
and will fill two of the orders. I thought
to fill an order as fast as possible and
not wait until we got a car load. I think
it advisable to go around to the grocers
and pay for a certain number of barrels
in advance. Then we have got a
sure thing and I think we will be able
to fill the whole order by degrees without
any great delay. This trouble about empty
barrels I am confident is spite work.
I must say I never encountered such

petty jealousies before in my life. I do not understand this place and long ago give up a solution of the problem.
