forms me that the Huribut & Northern
are bringing the 1200 tons and left Sunday.
Each have 700 tons. Passed Detroit on the
2nd. I do not know but what I may have
to load a few cars of stone to make some room.
Calculated on the Whitmore & Constant loading
yesterday and one with 600 tons. I hope that the
shipments by the time they get here would
make room enough. We can take 1000 tons
when one will unload but that does not
help us any at the other point. M^r Arm-
strong had an order in for 4 cars of stone
which I canceled on receipt of an order for
him from Capt Rhodes. I am confident
he wants the coal for he wrote me but I
suppose Capt Rhodes' order canceled the

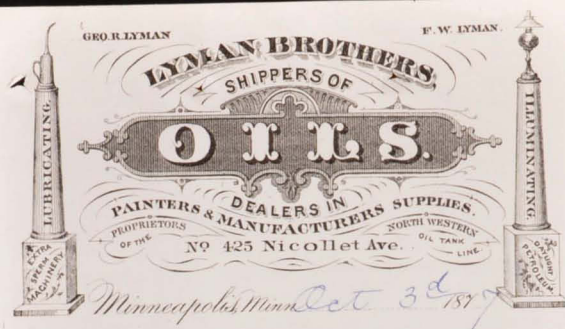
