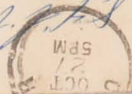

Dear Sir

We loaded
the car of stone and also of dirt for
P. Farley General Manager. This is all
the hard coal we loaded today. We made
the best we could to get good coal. It
is a little wet, outside of that I know
of no fault. We had a hard rain last
night and a mist this morning. So that
hard coal is in a state that makes it diffi-
cult to send out in a satisfactory condition.
I am sorry to state the N York Stone has a
great deal of dirt in it. It takes it a long
time to dry and when dry, it screens badly
so that it goes out looking bad. The dirt
so far is very good. A clean pile of coal even
if wet, soon dries out and goes out in
good shape. The cargo of 1160 Tons Stone for
F. A. Gager of H. A. was of this kind. All
of H. A. purchases from those parties have
been tolerably clean coal excepting a cargo
of quite last year and we have never had
