cent Would you object to instructing your agent at St. V. to be more particular and give our boats all the freight consigned to them, or ordered shipped by them. There are numerous instances where freights ordered shipped by boat have come by rail to St. Berufael I don't know that this is done willfuly, if not so, it is careless to say the least. Yesterday a car of B --- consigned to Malle & S --ordered by boat from St. V. & so contracted through, came to St. B. by rail. The rules you have adopted this season for the guidance of boat business from St. V. are bad enough for us in all ways without being swindeled out of part of our freight.

I have written to you twive about getting your approval to my appointment of a person at St. V. to represent our interest, but as yet have been unable to get any reply from you. The Pembuina Branch has a man with a desk in your office there.
