REPORT OF THE MINNESOTA EQUAL FRANCHISE LEAGUE.

*Seal of the

The Minnesota Equal Franchise League held its first Annual Convention at Minneapolis, Minnesota, on September, 5th, 1912.

This league is an incorporated society and its constitution includes many of the best plans of work which have at various times been tried by other suffrage societies. One month after this league was incorporated we had a membership of three hundred and sixty (360) which number has been doubled during the past two months and we hope that this rate of increase will continue until we pass the suffrage amendment in Minnesota. The special work which the league has undertaken is the most thorough organization of the state which may be possible before we have a campaign on. This is done through large county organizations guided in their work by large central committees.

Of the many clubs auxiliary to the League, two are young peoples' clubs. We are especially proud of our club of one hundred (100) high school students, (37) thirty seven of whom are boys and who have pledged themselves to vote for the suffrage amendment at the earliest possible moment, after they are twenty one years of age. This club is not only a suffrage club but is a study club as well, whose business programs include lessons in parliamentary law and the study of important social and political problems of the day. It is known as the "Jane Addams Addams Equality Club". Many of the ladies of our league are working among the young people of the state believing that by thus committing them to such lines of work early in life, many of our problems in regard to juvenile delinquency will become less annoying than they are at present. Another feature of the special work of the league is the contest among the students of the two hundred and eleven (211) high schools of the state for the best essay on the subject of suffrage for women. Although the committee on education has not as yet completed its plans there is much enthusiasm among the young people whom we hope will make many converts for the cause. The prize is to be known as the "Mrs Oliver H.P. Belmont Prize" and was contributed by to the League by our splendid co-worker and supported Mrs Oliver H.P. Belmont.

On the 9th day of November the Minnesota Suffragists held a mammoth jubilee meeting under the auspices of the Minnesota Equal Franchise League, at the commercial club rooms of the capital city, St. Paul. Following the speakers who numbered some of the oldest suffrage workers of the state, and after the musical program, the ceremony of pinning the four new stars to the suffrage flag took place.

This jubilee meeting was one of the most enthusiastic suffrage gatherings ever held and did much to arouse interest among the indifferent as well as to express the jubilant feelings of the suffragists assembled.

RAMSEY COUNTY REPORT AT PIPESTONE,  
July, 1916.

The work of the Ramsey County Suffrage Organization is progressing this year along much the same lines followed last year. We have perhaps in the last few months laid a little more emphasis on the necessity for strength and permanency of organization. Last year a great deal of canvassing was done and a great many "I Believe" cards were signed, but we felt that the returns in organization strength were not proportionate. Accordingly we started out in April arranging to have our Ramsey County headquarters at the Woman's Welfare League Rooms, which would give us a down town office, with a telephone and an office secretary to help with our files and record. While last year a great deal of canvassing was done in difficult districts by volunteer workers from other districts, we now feel that it is better to make each district responsible for its own work. Our plan has been to ask a group of representative women from each district to attend an informal tea at headquarters, to listen to a good suffrage speech and explanation of organization work. We thereby secure definite promises to work and arouse community pride in getting results.

Without waiting to complete our organization we have pushed suffrage speaking at every opportunity. Every W.C.T.U. group in Ramsey County is having at least one suffrage talk in a year. We also find Mothers' Clubs, Church societies and Sunshine branches willing to have suffrage speakers. We have found it helpful to take from each Sunday paper the list of club announcements for the week and ask permission from presidents and hostesses to send a speaker to as many as possible of the meetings. Having on file in the office a list of our best speakers, many of them willing to make weekly appointments, we are able to keep pace with the requirements. We believe thoroughly in this use of ready-made meetings. It is an easy and inexpensive kind of work and we get our arguments before a good many people who would not take the trouble to go to a suffrage meeting announced as such.

As only one of our six districts can be called at the present date, fairly well organized we see a great deal of work ahead. By next April when the second year of work is over, we hope to be able to give a much better account of our efforts. Although the work ahead looms large the response is so much more encouraging all the time that we are all working in the best of spirits.

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I - NAME

Hennepin County Woman Suffrage Association

ARTICLE II - OBJECT

Enfranchisement of women

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Any person ~~over~~ eighteen years of age who has signed an enrollment blank. *over*

ARTICLE IV - OFFICERS

Officers of the association shall consist of a president, vice president, chairman of the Board of Directors, vice chairman, executive secretary, and treasurer.

ARTICLE V - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The management of the affairs of the association shall be vested in a governing board which shall consist of the officers and five directors.

ARTICLE VI - ELECTION OF OFFICERS

The president, vice president and eight directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the association for the term of one year and shall serve until the election and qualification of their successors.

ARTICLE VII - ORGANIZATION OF THE BOARD

The Board of Directors shall meet within one week after adjournment of the annual meeting for the purpose of electing from their number a chairman, vice chairman and treasurer.

ARTICLE VIII - VACANCIES

The Board of Directors shall have power of election to fill a vacancy of either officer or director for an unexpired term. An affirmative vote of the entire board shall be necessary to so elect.

CONSTITUTION.

ARTICLE IX - QUORUM

A majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of the business of the association except that of election to fill an unexpired term of officer or director.

ARTICLE X - MEETINGS

There shall be an annual meeting of the association for the election of officers.

IX-LAWS

ARTICLE I - NOMINATIONS

Section 1. The Board of Directors shall appoint a nominating committee of three members of the association.

Section 2. The committee shall prepare an official ticket and shall then add to the ticket any names sent to the committee with ten endorsements. The entire ticket so composed shall be presented at the annual meeting for election.

ARTICLE II - EXECUTIVE SECRETARY

The Board of Directors shall appoint an executive secretary who shall devote a certain fixed portion of her working time to the duties of her office and whose salary shall be fixed by the Board.

ARTICLE III - ADVISORY COUNCIL

The Board of Directors shall appoint an advisory council composed of not more than fifteen members including the organizer of county work and the leaders of the nine legislative districts.

BY-LAWS

ARTICLE IV - MEETINGS

Section 1. Special meetings of the association may be called at any time by the Board of Directors.

Section 2. The Board of Directors shall meet once a week.

Section 3. At the last weekly meeting each month of the Board of Directors, the advisory council shall be present.

ARTICLE V - DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Section 1- President

The president shall preside at all general meetings of the association and shall represent the association at any and all state meetings; also shall preside at all public meetings held under the auspices of the association and shall perform such other duties as may be required by the Board of Directors.

Section 2- Vice President

In the absence of the president the vice president shall act in the capacity of president.

Section 3 -Chairman of Board of Directors

The chairman of the Board of Directors shall preside at all meetings of the Board and shall perform such other executive duties in connection with the work of the association as are not designated as duties of other officers.

The chairman of the board shall appoint from among the members of the board chairmen of the following standing committees:

Finance  
Legislative  
Extension  
Press

Upon recommendation of the chairmen of these committees the chairman of the board shall appoint members of the committees and organize special sub committees.

BY-LAWS

Section 4        -Treasurer

The treasurer shall be required to furnish a bond the cost of which shall be borne by the association. The treasurer shall receive and deposit all funds; also shall pay all bills in the name of the association upon warrants drawn and signed by the treasurer and executive secretary; shall make a monthly report to the board of directors of the financial affairs of the association. The books of the association shall be audited annually.

ARTICLE VI -        COUNTY ORGANIZATION

Section 1. The Board of Directors shall appoint an organizer of county work who shall organize the nine legislative districts of the county.

Section 2. The leader and other officers of each of these districts shall be elected by the district organization.

The name of this organization shall be the Men's League for Woman Suffrage of the State of New-York. Minnesota.

II

III

## PAUL THE ST. PAUL POLITICAL EQUALITY CLUB.

The St. Paul Political Equality Club is the local organization for the promotion of the cause of woman's suffrage. It is affiliated with the Minnesota Woman Suffrage Association. On December 10, 1901 the St. Paul Suffrage Club was organized with Mrs W.E. Rogers as president and Miss Fowble as secretary. Four years later a sister organization was formed calling itself the Sacajawea Suffrage Club thus commemorating in the name the notable Indian woman who guided the famous Lewis and Clark expedition. Mrs Margaret Pentland was president of this club and Mrs Parmer was secretary. It met monthly in the Neighborhood House on the West Side. These two clubs carried on their work side by side for three years when they wisely decided that one strong club would advance the cause more than two weak ones. Accordingly it was ~~ten~~ voted by both to unite.

The New Club was called the St. Paul Sacajawea Club but in September 1908, changed its name to the St. Paul Political Equality Club, a less romantic designation but one better expressing its purpose.

Several distinguished lecturers have come to St. Paul under the auspices of the club. Mrs Charlotte Perkins Gilman gave an informal talk at the Commercial Club Rooms in 1910, and the following year filled the Metropolitan Opera House and delivered a notable lecture that will be long remembered by those who heard it.

We had the pleasure of hearing Miss Sylvia Pankhurst the same winter, who in an able manner gave us the English point of view.

But possibly the most successful attempt of the club to get a public hearing for their cause was the lecture by the Rev. Dr. R.J. Campbell, of England, given at the Park Congregational Church during his brief stay in St. Paul in the past December. He addressed an audience that filled the church and he stirred the enthusiasm of every listener.

These public lectures are mentioned to show one way in which the club is working to develop a sentiment for suffrage in the public mind, and it feels that it is gaining ground every year. It is no longer hard to get new members in the club. Years ago it took a good deal of moral courage to publicly advocate women's suffrage because one felt that she must more or less defy the generally accepted standard of womanly propriety. This is not an easy thing to do and one must have a cause much at heart to attempt it. But at the present time getting new members is largely a matter of publicity, that is, letting people know there is a suffrage club in St. Paul.

## FOREWORD

The study for the year is the City Government of Winona. The object is to gain, by first hand inquiry and study, an understanding of the various departments of our municipal government in operation. We also wish to compare, when possible, with other cities of about our size and see whether their systems are more economical and efficient. We shall note especially the cost of maintaining the different departments.

The references are merely suggestive and not intended to be exhaustive. Much of the best material for papers is in magazine articles, and can be found by consulting the *Reader's Guide*.

Only such current events should be chosen as are of general, and likely to be of *permanent* interest. To avoid repetition, the others on the program should confer with the leader in the Review of the World.

## CONSTITUTION

### ARTICLE I.

This organization shall be called Political Equality League and shall be affiliated with the Minnesota Woman Suffrage Association.

### ARTICLE II.

The object of this League shall be to work for political, legal and industrial equality, and to study and prepare for the duties and responsibilities of women voters and also to stimulate interest in civic affairs, and shall be non-partisan in politics.

### ARTICLE III.

Any man or woman in sympathy with the object of this League may become a member by signing the constitution and paying the annual dues.

### ARTICLE IV.

Sec. 1. The officers of this League shall be a President, two Vice Presidents, a Secretary, a Treasurer and an Auditor. These general officers, with the chairmen of standing committees, shall constitute an Executive Board. One person may hold any two of said offices at one time, except the office of President, Vice President and Auditor.

Sec. 2. These officers shall be elected at the annual meeting, and shall serve for one year, or until their successors are elected.

Sec. 3. The Executive Board shall appoint the chairmen of such standing committees as shall be necessary to carry on the work of the League.

Sec. 4. Vacancies which occur in the Executive Board shall be filled by the Board.

#### ARTICLE V.

Sec. 1. The annual meeting of this League shall be held in March; time and place to be fixed by the Executive Board.

Sec. 2. The regular meetings shall be held at least once each month; time and place to be fixed by the Executive Board.

Sec. 3. Special meetings shall be called whenever the President or the Executive Board may deem expedient and order.

Sec. 4. The Executive Board shall meet at the call of the President or by request of any two members.

#### ARTICLE VI.

This constitution may be amended at any regular meeting by a two-thirds vote of the members present, provided a notice shall have been given of the proposed amendment at the previous meeting.

#### BY-LAWS

##### 1. Election of officers.

The officers of this League shall be nominated from the floor and shall be elected by ballot at the annual meeting.

##### 2. Duties of officers.

The duties of the officers shall be the same as pertain to all such officers, except the Treasurer.

The duty of the Treasurer shall be to receive all money of the League and collect outstanding dues; disbursing the same by order of the President and Secretary. She shall deposit all moneys of the League in some bank designated by the Executive Board and shall pay bills by check.

The Executive Board shall have general supervision over the affairs of the League and shall appoint all necessary committees.

##### 3. Dues.

The annual dues of this League shall be one dollar, payable in advance on or before the first meeting in September; ten cents of which shall be paid into the treasury of the Minnesota Woman Suffrage Association.

##### 4. Quorums.

Those present shall constitute a quorum at any regular meeting for the transaction of business.

Five members shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of the Executive Board.

5. "Longan's Parliamentary Rules Made Easy" shall govern in all places not covered by the Constitution and By-Laws.

The Woman's Welfare League of St. Paul has just-passed its fifth birthday.

Organized as a Civic Club including suffrage in our program we were early accepted in the Union-Suff. Assn. Later, because of our Civic tendency we were accepted in the Union-Federation of Woman's Clubs.

Our budget of ~~several thousand dollars~~ a year counts upon the budget of the Suff-Assn. X

Within the year some of our members have urged that we become a Ramsey Co. Suff. Assn., but the majority of our Executive Board preferred to remain a civic club with wider interests that need not be subordinated to suffrage.

Since then the Ramsey Co. Assn. has been formed with some of our most-able League members

as officers, and the Welfare League<sup>2</sup>  
keeps its club rooms open daily,  
at present donating the use of them  
to the Ramsey Co. and sharing with  
it the expense of a paid sec'y.

A glance at some of our League  
Committees will show the trend of  
our activities. In addition to the  
committees incident to organization  
we have "social conditions", "civic",  
"political education" and "suffrage  
extension committees".

A record of our activities for the  
past year consumes space to the  
extent of over 90 typewritten pages.

Through the initiation of and under  
the leadership of very able chairmen  
of these committees we have had a  
long list of educational programs  
upon civic, national and international  
progress, and measures pending in  
Congress and State Legislature: and  
many times we have thrown our

influence either for or against measures which we felt to be helpful or hurtful to the public. X

We have been ever mindful of the interests of suffrage. Much suffrage news on our programs and letters and resolutions addressed to the President and members of Congress and Legislature bear ample testimony to this fact. Through our suffrage education committee many of our members have done arduous work in the interests of organization.

Recently the League united with the Ramsey Co. Assn. in a money making enterprise which netted about \$1000 to be used for further work.

Since America entered the war our attendance and interest have kept up as usual. The majority of our programs have been on related subjects with continuous effort to play a helpful part in the war.

situation. Nearly all of our women  
are working hard for The Red Cross;  
many sold liberty-bonds, and we  
are taking an active interest in  
food conservation.

We have had a special committee to cooperate with The Y. M. C. A. in furnishing entertainment at Snelling. This committee has taken many musicians to The Fort.

We were one of the very first-groups to donate a goodly sum of money toward making The Fort-club house attractive for the men; and we are about to try the experiment of opening our club rooms one evening in the week to entertain a group of soldiers in the city for the evening.

One of the satisfying features of efforts in behalf of men in the Army is the fact that all civilians asked to lend aid and comfort respond with eager sympathy.

Every one

The League has at present  
the largest paid up membership  
in its history.

We feel that the struggle for
