FREEDOM AWARD TO SERGEI KOVALYOV

WASHINGTON, DC

MAY 3, 1995

IN EVERY AGE THERE ARE HEROIC AND COURAGEOUS MEN AND WOMEN WHO APPRECIATE THAT THE WORK OF DEMOCRACY AND FREEDOM IS THE UNFINISHED BUSINESS OF HUMANITY -- AND THEY DEDICATE THEIR LIVES TO DO SOMETHING CREATIVE AND CONSTRUCTIVE ABOUT IT. IN OUR AGE, THE PEOPLES OF RUSSIA AND THE FORMER SOVIET UNION HAVE PRODUCED SUCH MEN AND WOMEN OF CONVICTION IN RELATIVELY LARGE NUMBERS. ELENA BONNER'S PRESENCE HERE THIS AFTERNOON REMINDS UF OF THAT FACT. FREEDOM HOUSE, FROM THE FIRST DAYS OF ITS BIRTH MORE THAN 50 YEARS AGO, HAS ASSOCIATED ITSELF WITH THEIR ASPIRATIONS AND HAS MOBILIZED ITS RESOURCES TO BE OF ASSISTANCE.

IT WAS A SOURCE OF GREAT PERSONAL INSPIRATION FOR ME WHEN, IN SEPTEMBER 1991, AS I RETURNED TO GOVERNMENT SERVICE FOR ONE MONTH, I LEARNED THAT MY RUSSIAN COLLEAGUE AT THE MOSCOW CSCE MEETING ON THE HUMAN DIMENSION, WOULD BE DR.

SERGEI KOVALYOV, A WIDELY ACKNOWLEDGED LEADER OF THE INTERNATIONAL MOVEMENT FOR HUMAN RIGHTS.

THE SYMBOLISM OF THAT APPOINTMENT WAS DRAMATIC. THE WORLD WAS BEING TOLD THAT RUSSIA WAS JOINING THE FAMILY OF DEMOCRATIC STATES. FOR ME, HOWEVER, IT WAS MORE THAN SYMBOLISM AND DRAMA. MEETING DR. KOVALYOV WAS ENCOURAGING IN ITS REASSURANCE THAT THE HUMAN SPIRIT DEMANDED AND WAS DESTINED TO ACHIEVE DIGNITY AND FREEDOM.

FOR SOME, THE PERSONAL RECOGNITION WOULD HAVE BEEN REASON FOR SELF-CONGRATULATION. FOR DR. KOVALYOV, THERE WAS A REALIZATION THAT THE STRUGGLE FOR HUMAN RIGHTS AND DEMOCRACY WAS A CONTINUING ONE AND THAT HIS COUNTRY WAS ONLY AT THE BEGINNING OF A LONG AND DIFFICULT ROAD.

VICTORIES AS WELL AS DEFEATS. HIS CONTINUED LEADERSHIP IN THE CAUSE OF FREEDOM, IN THE FACE OF CAUSTIC THREATS AND CRITICISM, IS EVEN MORE SIGNIFICANT.

DR. KOVALYOV, WE GIVE YOU THE FREEDOM HOUSE FREEDOM
AWARD NOT ONLY AS AN EXPRESSION OF OUR APPRECIATION, BUT,
EQUALLY IMPORTANT, AS AN EXPRESSION OF OUR SUPPORT FOR ALL
THE FORCES IN YOUR COUNTRY, YOUR COLLEAGUES, WHO ARE
DETERMINED THAT RUSSIA WILL BOTH ASPIRE AND ATTAIN A LEADING

ROLE AMONG THE NATIONS OF THE WORLD FOR FREEDOM AND DIGNITY FOR ALL.
