The Club has a Speakers Bureau where in speakers are made available to address various groups such as schools, clubs, etc. on topics dealing with India.

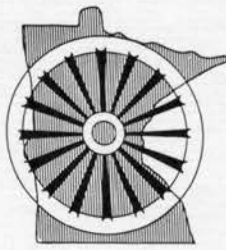
India Club has published "India: A Resource Guide for Minnesotans".

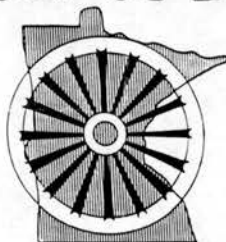

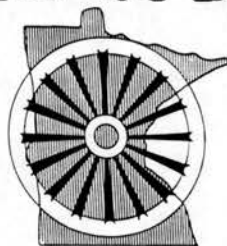
