

**Records of insurance policies on church buildings of the N[orth] W[est] Swedish Insurance Association  
1892-1900**

*TRANSLATOR COMMENT:* The above title is identified as Vol. 14 in the Minnesota Historical Society's collection of the records of the First Swedish Methodist Episcopal Church of St Paul, Minnesota.

On the outside front cover it is identified as "Book A".

The first pages of the volume are specifically identified alphabetically, i.e. "A", "B", "C", etc. These pages are an index to the subsequent numerical numbered pages. This series of pages are formally organized and ruled as an account book. I shall use this page format/organization in the following translation.

I shall not try to duplicate entries as they actually appear but give their essential meaning and appearance. I shall however spell proper names as they are written.
