

Hather. you know that two summers ago, we attended a Great Council at Thairie des lehiens, where by the advice of our white friends, we made a peace with the Sine. He were then told that the Americans would quarantee our safety under your flag. Me came here under that assurance; But father lade at your floor, it is stained with the

blood of my people, shed under your walls. I look up & see your flag over us. If you are a great & powerful people why do you not protect us? If not, of what use are all these soldiers? Spitual as translated. Reel Boat Rock Islander Regt Orders August 6th 1827 On the arrival of the boats at the Prairie on which Wabasha's village is situated & at a place which will be indicated by the bolonel, the Lot Infantry under Let Denny with Let Jameson as second office will land & march in file towards the village, keeping as near as possible panallel to the boats. An advanud quand to be detailed from Lot Low's company of one Corporal & three privates, will move two hundred gards in front of the Light Infantry. They will not attempt concealment, but go directly to the village by the common frath, and inform Malisha or any of his chiefs who may be present that although we approach in force, we have no hastile intentions. Our only object is to return to St Veters unmolested. If the advance should be fired on, or made prisoners, Lot Denny will form his company in line in extended order

and fire advancing towards the orllage. The other three companies will immediately land & support him. They will form line in extended order, & whatever may be the casualties, they will advance to the houses in the village. Averagements have been made to fire them, & it is expufely injoined on the offices & men to give no quarter, but to women & children whose persons should always be sacred in the eyes of an American soldier. Once engaged in this enterprize, courage is safety, and the misconduct of one individual may produce a panie in the whole line. It is therefore enjoined upon every officer to put to death any man who quite his rank, or allements to escape from his duty. Shelling Gol com! August 10th 1827.
