This competition is restricted to original paintings in watercolor, framed or unframed but suitably matted. Mat sizes 24" x 30" or 28" x 36". Framed works should be no larger than 36" x 48" outside sizes.

ARTISTS ELIGIBLE

Open to any artist residing in the 50 states of the United States of America.

NUMBER OF ENTRIES

No more than three paintings may be submitted by any one artist. Identification card must be completed and attached securely to the back of each painting.

HANDLING FEE

Each artist must pay a \$5.00 handling fee regardless of the number of paintings entered, 1, 2, or 3. Only checks or money orders accepted, and should be made payable to Wichita Centennial National Art Exhibit. Fees are not returnable. Fees must accompany Entry Card(s).

DATES FOR RECEIVING PAINTINGS

Paintings will be received between March 21, 1970 and April 4, 1970. All paintings received after April 9 will be returned at the artist's expense, unopened.

Paintings may be delivered or shipped to WCNAE receiving agent:

All shipments must be sent prepaid or they will not be accepted from the carrier. Bulk shipments by professional fine arts forwarding services will be accepted only if the forwarding service accepts the responsibility of collecting the required handling fee and forwarding same to WCNAE, P.O. Box 1969, Wichita, Kansas 67201.

Check local postal regulations on shipment restrictions.

ACCEPTANCE, REJECTION

All paintings will be hung if selected by the jury. Paintings will be returned, collect freight, after June 19. All selected work delivered by hand must be picked up no later than July 1.

Paintings rejected will be returned collect freight as soon as possible following jury decision. All rejected work delivered by hand must be picked up no later than June 15.

LIABILITY

Entries will be handled with all possible care, but the WCNAE will not be responsible for loss or damage from any cause whatsoever. Sending a work of art to this exhibition shall imply an agreement on the part of the artist with the above condition. Unless notified to the contrary, the WCNAE Executive Committee will assume the privilege of photographing or using any painting entered in the exhibition for the purpose of publicity or catalogue reproduction.

EXHIBIT

Accepted works will be exhibited in Center City, CENTURY II Cultural Center from May 24 through June 19, 1970.

COMMISSION

There will be a 20% commission charged for the sale of any work from the exhibition. This does not include Purchase Award-Winning Paintings. All paintings will be correctly labeled and priced according to information furnished by the artist. The 20% commission must be included in the price furnished by the artist.

CATALOGUES

All winners will be illustrated in the catalogue of the Wichita Centennial National Art Exhibit, Catalogues will be sold to the public. Accepted artists will receive one free copy.
