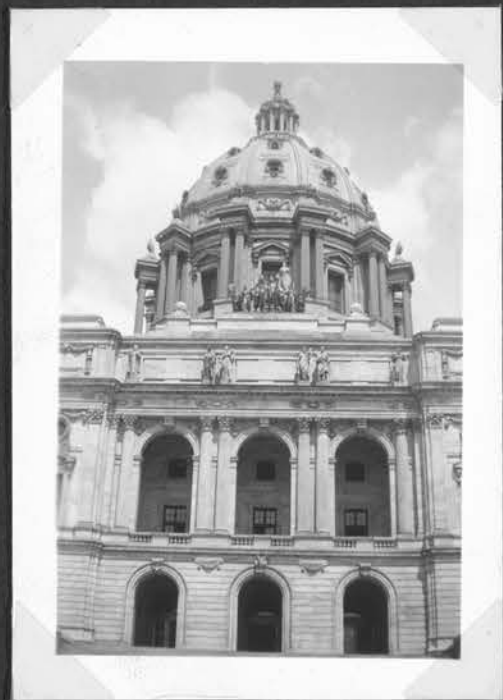

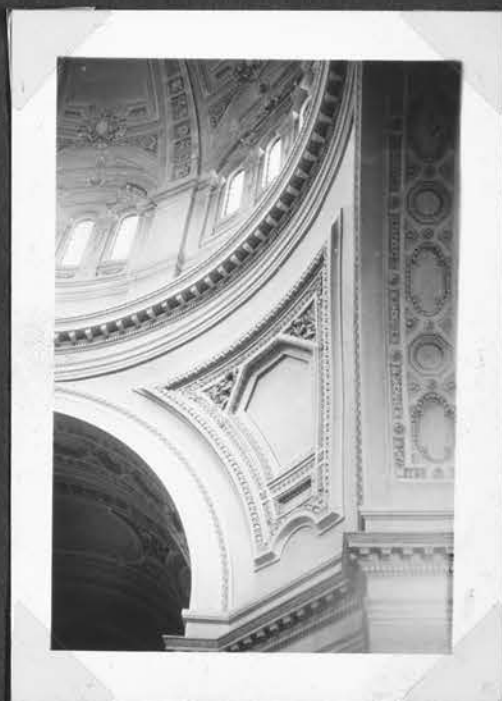


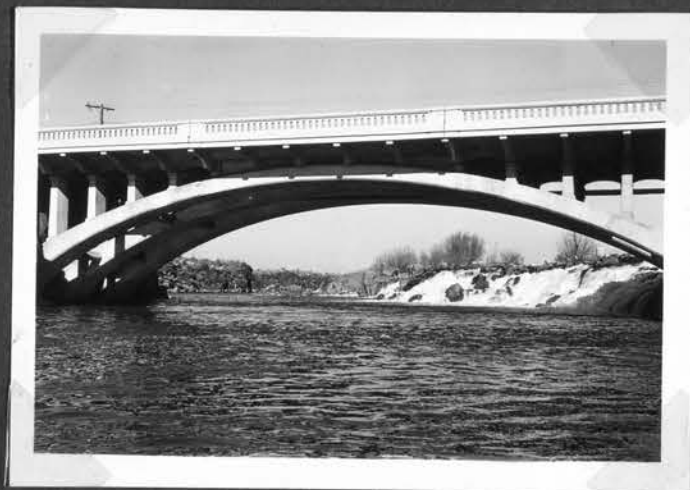








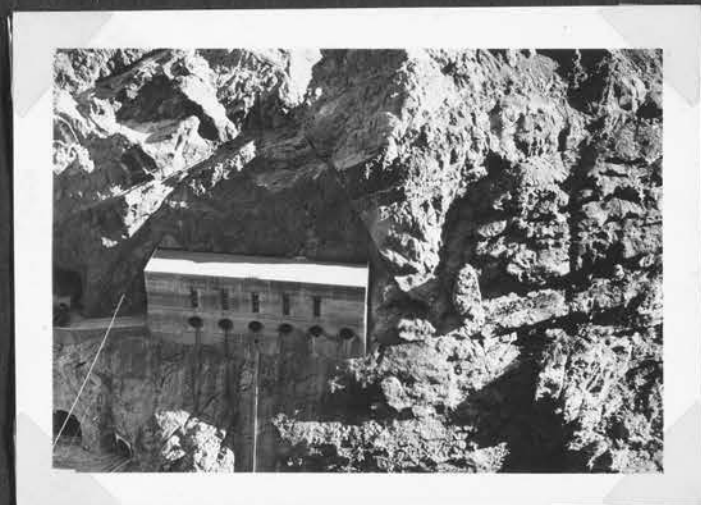
















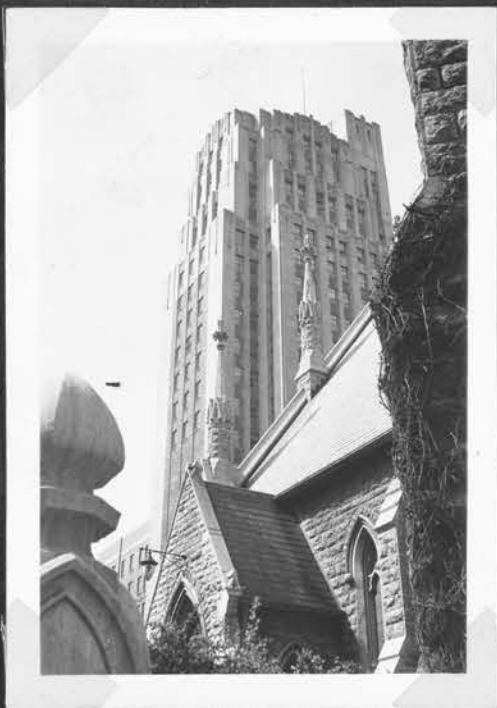
New Brighton (u. left)
