



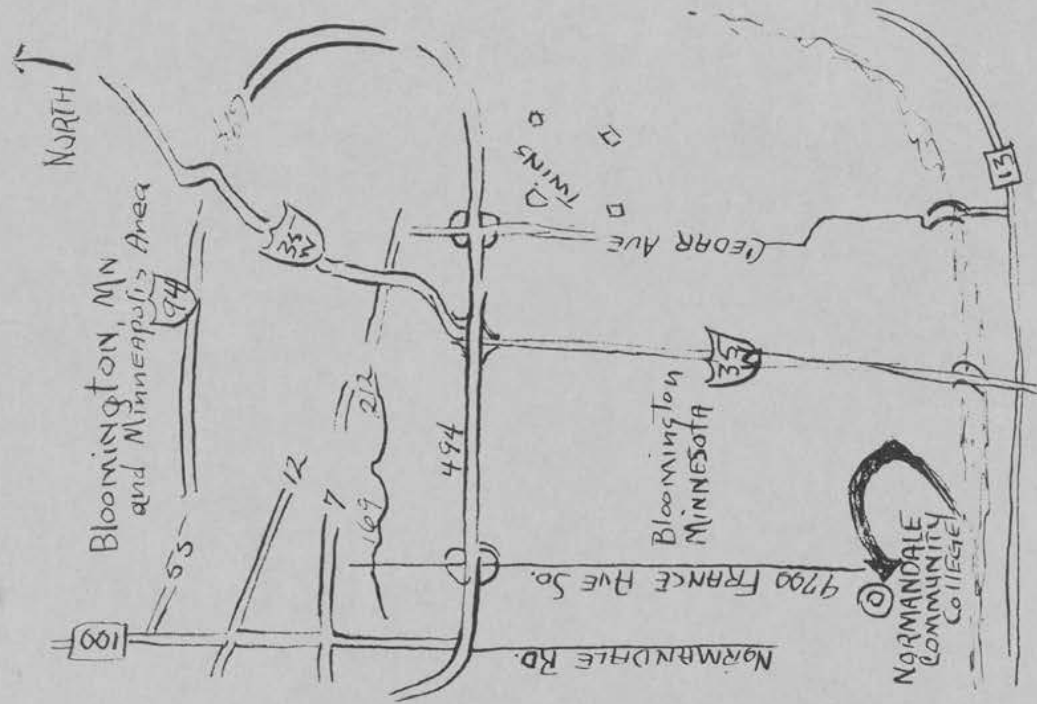
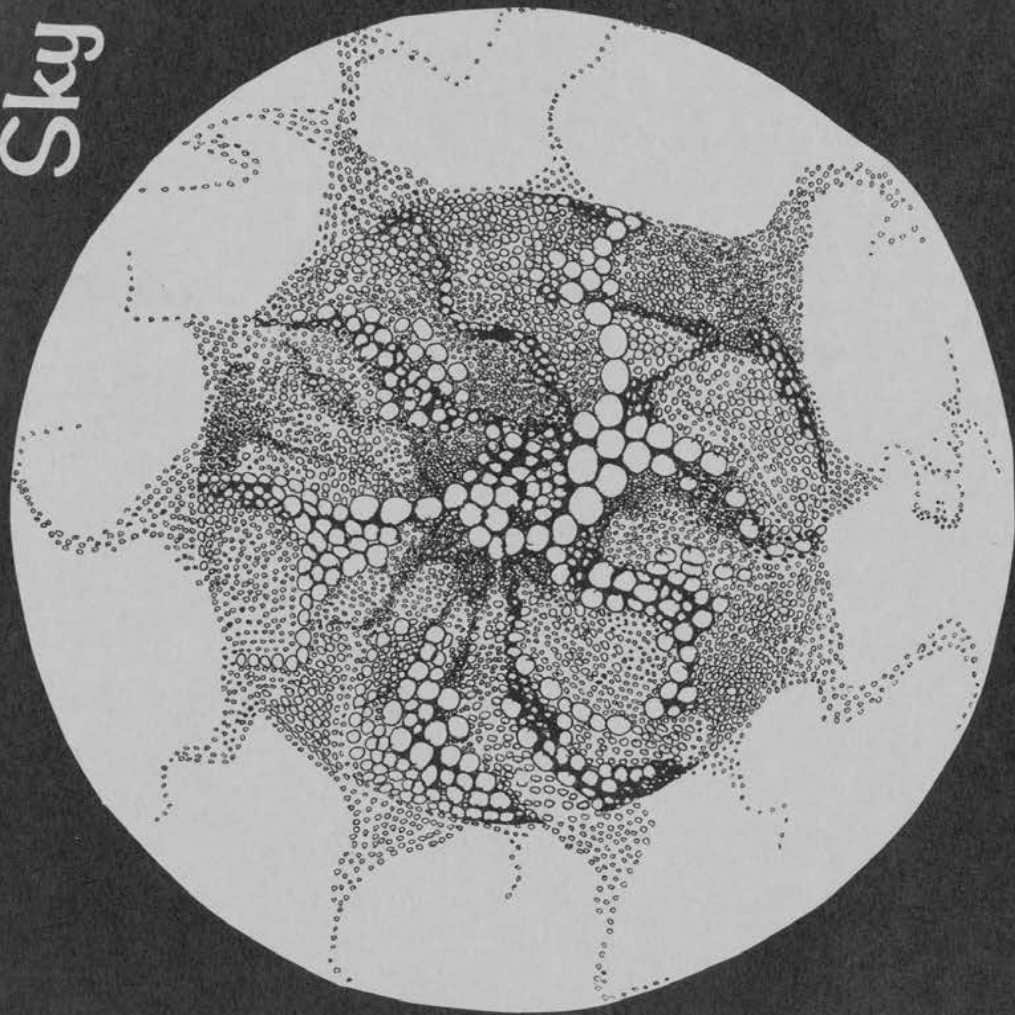

ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all artists residing in Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Goodhue, Hennepin, Ramsey, Scott and Washington Counties, and including all Fine Arts Society members.

ENTRY FEE:

A non-refundable charge of \$3.00 per art work must accompany registration forms, payable to the SKY GALLERY. There is a limit of two pieces of art per person. Please note that over 50% of entry fee will be used for cash awards.

MEDIA:

Paintings (all media): two-dimensional work under glass (watercolor, drawings, prints, pastels); sculpture; photographs.

CONDITIONS:

Paintings must be dry and completely ready to hang with wire and screw eyes. Watercolors, drawings, prints, and pastels must be under glass. All work must be original and completed within the last year. Copies will not be accepted. Work done under instruction will be accepted only if executed solely by the student. The committee reserves the right to reject unsuitable entries.

SIZE:

Maximum dimensions of paintings accepted are 3 feet by 4 feet. Maximum dimensions of sculpture accepted are 6 feet high, 3 feet wide and 100 pounds. Fragile work will not be accepted.

SALES:

Any art work sold from this exhibition will be handled through the SKY GALLERY (950 South Robert Street, West St. Paul) at a 25% commission. If work is not for sale, mark "NFS" in appropriate space on registration form.

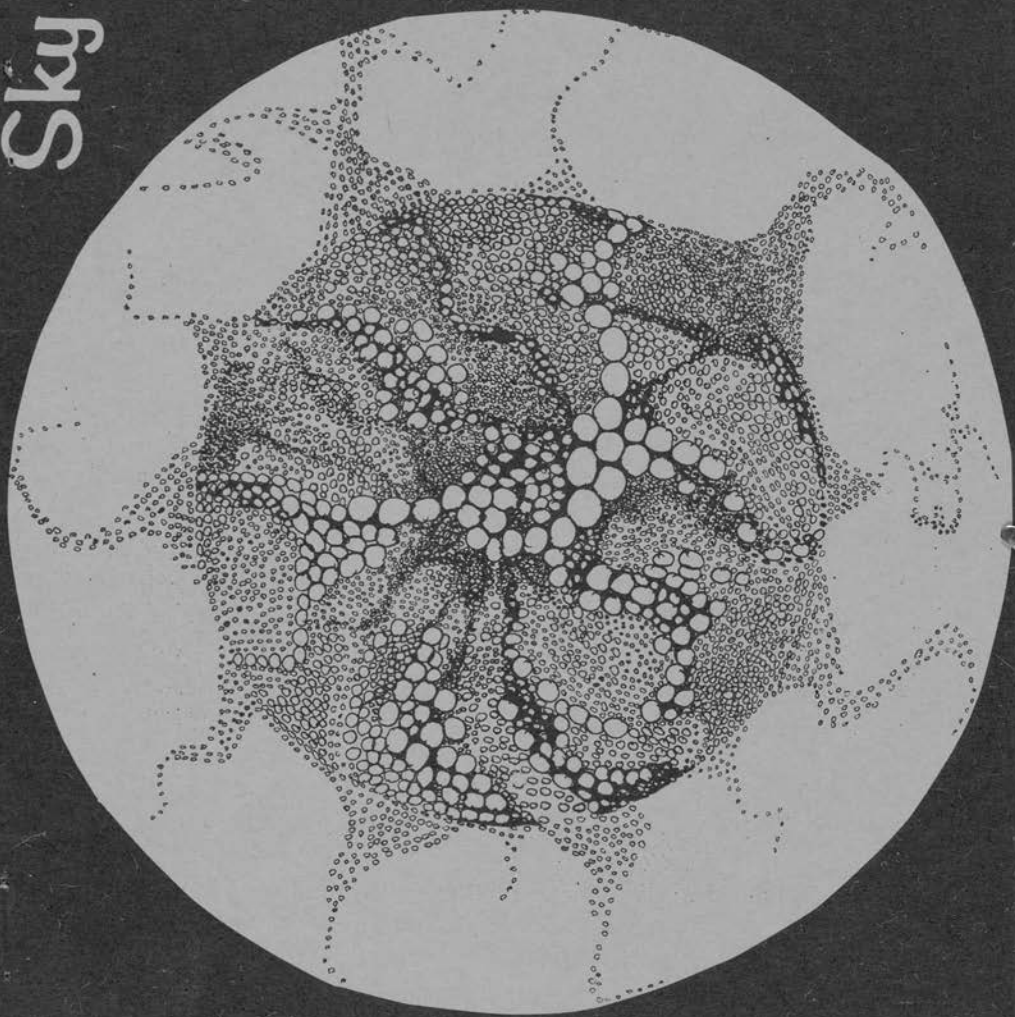

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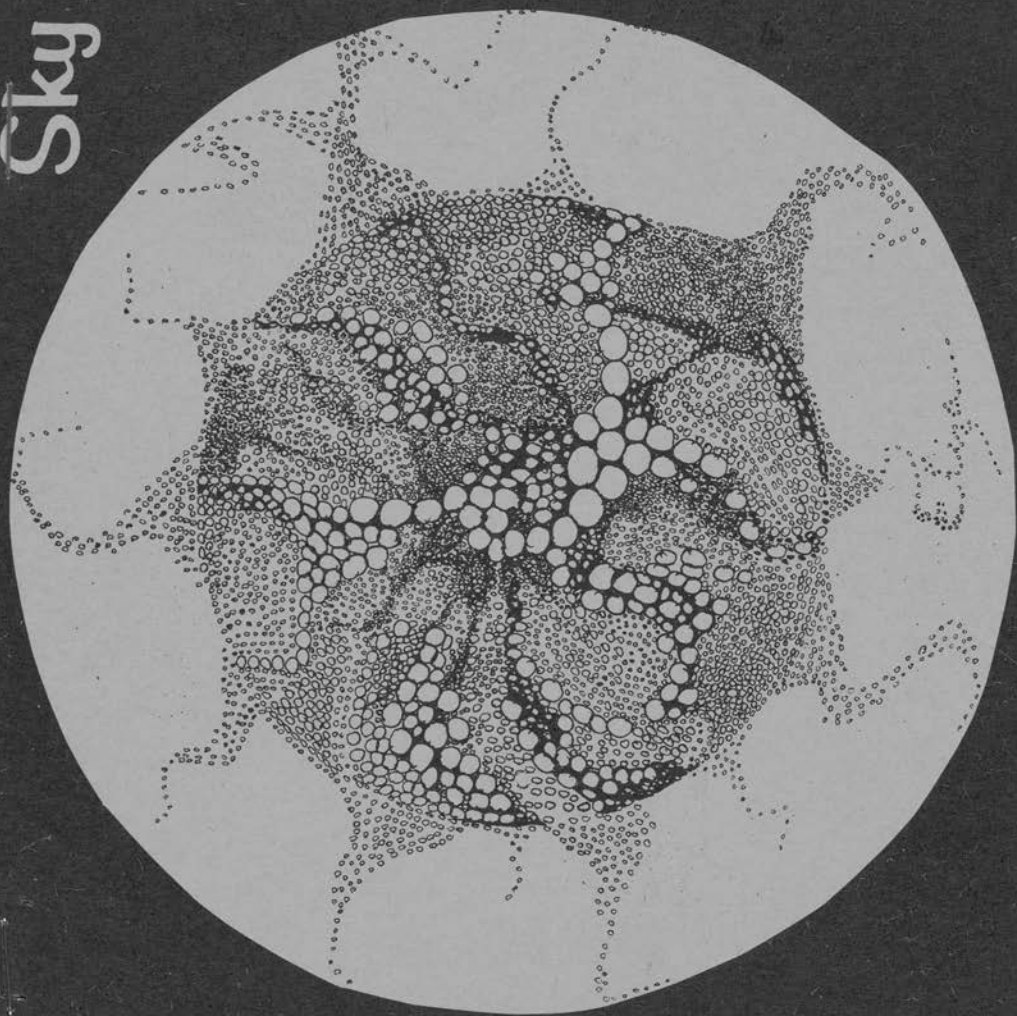

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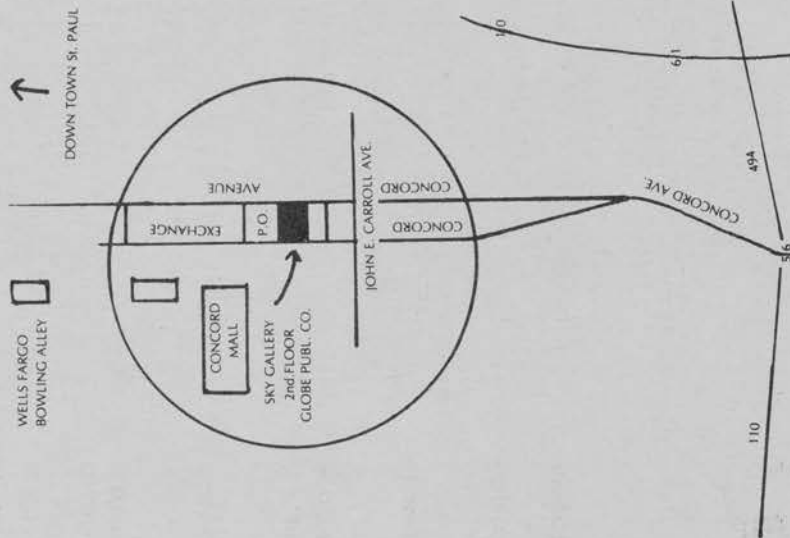

ACTIVITIES

The first Art Fair was held in 1960, and has been continued and expanded through the years to two annual fairs - one of fine arts and another of crafts with a great many artists from the area exhibiting.

The Arts Omnibus Show, a combination of paintings and flower arrangements from area garden clubs, is held in August. It is sponsored and held at the Twin City Federal Savings & Loan in St. Paul. This is the most popular juried show of its type to be seen in the Twin Cities, and has drawn visitors from a wide area.

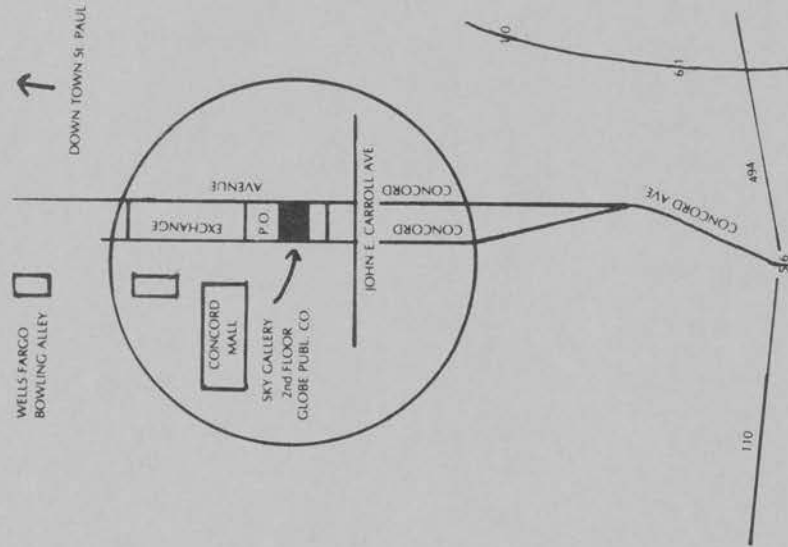
