Notes from September 23, 1998 Community Circle Conversations (CCC) Meeting

Present: Barbara Blackstone, Scott Bol, Janine Freij, Brenda Eccleston, Rita Keltgen, Dick Little, Amy Rodquist, Thomas Ross

1. What Has Been Done

- Thomas Ross developed a commitment letter for participants.
- Thomas Ross drew up a study circle roster for participants.
- In regard to participation by disabled persons, Amy may be able to find sign language interpreters. Scott Bol will be the person to contact if anyone has a participant with special needs. Requests will have to be handled on a case by case basis.
- Dick Little talked to Ross Taylor who definitely thinks that school board members will want to participant.
- Joanne Nelson faxed information to Central Chicano.
- Dick Little has been in contact with The League of Women Voters who may be able to provide trained persons to act as recorders.
- A press release has been sent to a number of community and ethnic papers.
- A promotional flyer that includes a registration form has been developed.
- Several participants have been identified. It was agreed that Scott will collect names and sites they will attend citywide and make sure those names get to site coordinators.
- Longfellow United For Youth and Family has officially endorsed the project.
- George Brady of **Work With Dignity** wants to participate in these talks and thinks that others he knows through his work will also be interested.
- FACES Youth Services Coordinator was approached. She has some significant concerns. Her experience has shown that kids who are invited to join a group like this often are not included in the discussion in a significant way. She suggested that a form that overviews strategies for making sure that are youth who come to these and other discussions are full participants. **This committee agreed** that it will be important for CCC facilitators to be aware of the need to make sure any youth who attend are included as full participants.
- A number of assigned contacts with community organizations have been initiated. In a many cases the contact has been initial or committee members are waiting for returned phone calls.

2. What Needs To Be Done

- All will continue with the contact activity overviewed at the last meeting.
- Thomas will call Affordable Housing Campaign to reinforce Scott's request.
- Dick will make sure that the study guide is completed and ready to give to facilitators ASAP.

- Thomas will work on getting air time on KMOJ.
- Dick will work on getting air time on KFAI
- Rita will do a flyer for each conversation.
- Rita will send out PSAs.
- Dick and Thomas will work on getting coverage from the Star Tribune.
- Barbara and Dick will continue to work on facilitator preparation. We are hopeful that facilitators can meet together once before conversations begin.
- Jaynine will contact Bryan Coyle Center about possible participation.
- Dick will continue to work with the League of Women Voters to get recorders.
- Dick will work on contacting school board members and the Civil Rights Commission.
