Capt. Flandrau New Ulm Sir:

I have just returned from near the Fort. When within 6 miles saw two large volumes of smoke & heard firing of guns. When within ½ mile of the Hill on this side, Saw one man dead with his throat cut & could [see] two distinct fires, one no doubt the Gov't stables & the other Randals house or stables. I returned from there & will go to St. Peter tonight. If you can spare a force you had better send to their relief or the Fort may fall into the hands of the Indians.
