Bulletin to Departments.

At the meeting of the Deans' Committee the 10th instant the Comptroller was instructed to issue sample budget sheets showing the use of symbols and a second sheet showing the new plan of recommending salary increases, re-appointments, promotions and so forth that require loard action. In explanation I will refer to sheet 1 and 2. Following is the explanations of the symbols:

A twelve months' service
B forty weeks' service
C special term service
D supplemental appointment
E nine months' appointment
H part time appointment
X substitute appointment

On sheet 1 you will note that item 1 of the payroll is an A appointment, regular salary \$5,000. The * indicates a note below which explains that the appointee is absent on sabbatical leave. In the preparation of the budget we have always used the * symbol to indicate an absence. The B symbol indicates forty weeks' service and payment will be made in ten installments. The first payment will be made October 1st and will be for one-half month's salary. Item 5, C, indicates a special term appointment and the - indicates note below explaining that the appointee is scheduled for first semester only. Item 6, B-X, the B indicates a forty weeks' appointment, the X a substitute appointment and the (1) indicates that it is substitute on account of leave of absence under item 1. Item 7, B-D, indicates the forty weeks' service with special appointment for additional work for the month of August. Item 10, E, indicates a nine months' appointment. There will be a half month's pay for the month of September and a half month's pay for the month of June, the intervening months will be on full pay. Item 11, H is for part-time temporary appointments. The appointments under this class should be recommended to the President, whenever practicable, at least two weeks before the work begins and

copies of these appointments, in fact all appointments, should be sent to the pay-roll clerk in the Business Office.

It is desired that the budget show the exact status of the appointment. In the event there is considerable broken up time I respectfully refer you to the Dentistry budget, see page 80, item 57. The symbol used indicates 11 1/2 one-half days. Assuming this to be a forty weeks appointment in addition the symbol B would be used, whereas for item 78 the symbol indicates 6 half days and as the instructor works twelve months the symbol A would be used.

Explanation of Sheet 2.

Items 2, 3 and 4 indicate increases in salary. Item 7 indicates a supplemental appointment for the month of August only. Item 8 represents an increase of \$300 and also a promotion from instructor to assistant professor. Item 9 indicates an increase of salary and re-appointment of instructor for the year 1918-19. In the event a three year appointment expired and a re-appointment were desirable, the re-appointment should read for three years.

I should recommend that pages of the 1917-18 budget, which may be procured at the Business Office, be used for indicating the budget for next year by changing names and figures and adding the symbols. If, however, there are too many changes it might be re-written. It would greatly facilitate the Business Office if the additions and deductions were indicated by the departments as shown on Sheet 1, the proportion of J. L. Roe's salary charged to History, \$1,000.

But no sentence of a court-martial shall be carried into execution until after the whole proceedings shall have been laid before the officer, ordering the same, or the officer commanding the trrops for the time being; neither shall any sentence of a general court-martial, extending to the loss of life, either in time of peace or war, be carried into execution, until after the whole proceedings shall have been transmitted to the Secretary of War, to be laid before the President of the United States for his confirmation or disapproval, and orders in the case.
