## Move to Oust General Wood

Report Adopted by Congress Conferees Also Affects Two Other Officers.

Washington, June 11 .- The senate yesterday, by a vote of 27 to 24, adopted the report of senate and house conferees containing a number of antiadministration provisions on the army appropriation bill. One of these provisions would legislate out of office General Leonard Wood, present chief of staff of the army. As agreed to, the bill would require army officers acting as chief of staff, after March 4 next, to have at least ten years' service in the line with rank below brigadier.

The provisions were the subject of a three-hour bitter debate. It was contended the chief of staff restriction was directed at General Wood and that it had been inserted by the conferees without the consent of either house.

The provision also would affect unfavorably General Funston and Colonel Goethals.

The house has not yet adopted the report, but probably will do so today.

The discussion was acrid at times. Adverse criticism was voiced against the provision creating a commission to consider the discontinuance of many army posts throughout the country.



#### Of Revolutionary Descent.

John Harrington Stevens was born June 13, 1820, in Brompton, Quebec, of old New England stock. His mother was a daughter of Dr. John Harrington, a Revolutionary soldier. As a young man Stevens went west and was engaged in various ways in the lead mining country in Illinois and Wisconsin, living chiefly at Galena. He enlisted for service in the Mexican war in 1846 and served with General Pillow and General Zachary Taylor and finally accompanied General Winfield Scott's army from Vera Cruz to Mexico, taking part in the famous battles of Contreras, San Antonio, Chrubusco, Molino del Rey and Chapultepec. After serving two years he resigned his commission on account of sore eyes.

Returning to Galena he made plans for entering a homestead in Texas, but was induced by various acquaintances to turn his way un the Mississippi. He took passage on the "Dr. Franklin" on which Russel Blakeley was clerk. On the boat he had as traveling companions Henry H. Sibley and H. M. Rice, who afterwards were to play such prominent parts in the development of

Minnesota.

After leaving La Crosse the only signs of civilization disclosed were the small trading posts at Reed's Landing and Hastings. There were Indian villages at the maces where Wabasha, Red Wing and Wacouta now stand, and only the tangled wilderness at Wirona and Lake City.

#### Came in 1849.

April 20, 1849, Mr. Stevens and his distinguished fellow travelers debarked at St. Paul. After getting himself located, Mr. Stevens and a party of land hunters set out to look for land. They went up the east bank of the river several days, but the soil looked too

## FATHER OF MINNEAR

Unveiling of Statue to Take Place Monday on 63rd Anniversary of Building of the First House in Minneapolis -- The City Grew Up Around the Home of Colonel Stevens.

A brouze statue of Colonel John Harrington Stevens, to be unveiled at Stevens square, Grant street and Portland avenue, Monday at 3 p.m., will be a reminder to the people of Minneapolis of the first settler in Minneapolis on the west side of the river.

The statue, life size, mounted on a granite pedestal, will be unveiled by Miss Newell Chase of Rapid City, S. D., a granddaughter of Colonel Stevens, and accepted for the city by Mayor J. C. Haynes and for the park board by E. J. Phelps.

M., which was organized by Colonel Stevens and seven other Masons in February, 1851; by J. B. Gilfillan and Fred L. Smith, pastmasters of the lodge; by Eli Pettijohn, George A. Brackett and Edwin Clark as representatives of the Hennepin County Territorial Pioneers' association.

The statue was made on the order of Mrs. P. B. Winston, daughter of Colonel Stevens, who died last fall, and will be presented by Professor A. W. Parkin of the state university, a nephew, on behalf of the family.

#### Founder of City.

Founder of City.

If any of the early settlers about the Falls of St. Anthony is entitled to live in history as 'the father of Minneapolis,' the title should be conferred on Colonel Stevens. He was not the first settler by a number of years nor did he lay the foundation for the industries that later made the city great, but his home was the nucleus around which the city grew, he was active in the work of laying the educational and moral foundation of the city on a broad basis and he watched over all the interests of the budding village with most paternal solicitude and affection.

Colonel gave the names to Hennepin and Nicollet avenues and other streets. He also applied such names as Minnetonka, Helen and California, to the avenues toward the south, but many years afterward a practical council gave the city its present system of numerical nomenclature.

He helped organize the first school district on the west side of the river, induced merchants and settlers to come to the city by liberal gifts of town lots and was the pioneer of the present army of boosters.

Built First House.

Built First House.

When Colonel Stevens began in 1849 to build the first house on the west side there were several on the east side, for St. Anthony was organized before Minneapolis, but because of Colonel Stevens' generosity, in great measure, Minneapolis in a few years annexed St. Anthony and removed it from the map.

Colonel Stevens likewise was the father of Hennepin county. He presented the bill creating the county out of Dakota county and fought it through the legislature, the measure passing on the last working day of the session of 1852 by a sparse majority. In his "recollections" Colonel Stevens speaks of the work before the legislature as his first and last experience wearied him not so much for the waste of time and money, but for the nature of his efforts, which he declared would be repugnant to any man, as he was "tipable to lose his self-respect." 

Mr. Stevens found it to his advantage in 1857 to leave Minneapolis and locate on a farm near Glencoe. While living in McLeod county he was sent three times to the legislature, twice to the house and once to the senate. He was to see one more term in the legislature, representing Minneapolis in that body during the session of 1876.

Colonel Stevens was at Glencoe when the Sioux began the historic massacre and with his customary promptness and ability he organized the settlers in the vicinity and refugees into a fighting force, drilled them and fortified the place, so that when Captain Richard Strout arrived from Minneapolis with a company to relieve the place everything was in shape to repel an attack and the party was able to go to the relief of the unprotected places further west. For his services Colonel Stevens received the personal thanks of Governor Alexander Ramsey and a commission as major general of the state militia.





Old settlers, city officials and the general public turned out yesterday afternoon to attend the unveiling of the statue of Col. John H. Stevens, pioneer settler who built the first house in Minneapolis. Reminiscenses of old days were recalled and tributes paad to the memory of Colonel Stevens. When Miss Newell Chase, of Rapid City, S. D., granddaughter, lowered the flags which exposed the statue to view old settlers stood with heads uncovered as the audience cheered.

Yesterday was chosen for the event as it was the sixty-third anniversary of the day Colonel Stevens pre-empted the claim on the west bank of the Mississippi river, which later became the site of the first dwelling house erected in the criginal city of Minneapolis. The little frame building was removed later to Minnehaha park, where it is preserved as a relic of early days, and is visited by thousands of tourists annually.

### Records to Be Examined Before Couples Marry

Methodist Preachers of Chicago Believe This Will Lessen the Number of Separations.

Declared 100,000 Decrees Were Granted in United States Last Year.

Chicago, June 11 .- Methodists preach ers of Chicago yesterday agreed that hereafter they would refuse to marry divorced persons who refuse to grant 10 days for the examination of their records. These preachers believe that this precaution will tend to lessen the number of divorces.

The action was taken after Francis Miner Moody of San Francisco, field secretary of the California state commission of marriage and divorce, had given the clergymen some facts about the growth of divorce in this

"There have been 100,000 divorces granted in the United States in the last year," he said.

"That is seven times as many as were granted in Europe. Divorce, since 1870, has increased three and a half times as rapidly as the population.

"Vigo county, Indiana, holds the divorce record, having more separations on its books than Reno, Nev. is worse than South Dakota and California is the worst state in the Union.

"Preachers should not accept the word of a stranger seeking to be married. No bank will cash a \$5 check for a stranger, but will require identification, yet preachers will marry strangers, provided they have a license.

"A uniform divorce law is the remedy for the divorce evil."


