I discover that ~~Congress~~ ^{Congress} "Full faith and credit shall be given to public acts records and in Sect 3 - "The Congress shall have power to dispose of and make all ^{new} rules and regulations respecting the Territory - and nothing - shall be done as to prejudice any claims &c.

Their credulity might be wrought upon and they would discover a greater degree of superiority in the Genius of the White People than those of their own Complexion ~~But~~ ^{But} I hope I shall be excused in attempting to hint any addition to your superior wisdom - my proper sphere is to negotiate for the peace of Capt. Caen - I cannot help fostering a secret ^{confidence} ~~hope~~ that you will be pleased to write in answer to my request ^{confidential} ^{obligation} upon your Excellency's unworthy thought humble servant J H
