

Salem, Washington 11 June 1806
my Dear Son, — Samuel Harrison Esqr —

I am here as witness — I must return
to New York in four days — I hope you got
home in perfect Health, I found your
wife & family well, and likewise all the
Friends of & at Greenville —

no Letter from you has reached me since
your departure from N. York — yet I heard
you had passed Judge Thornes House without
calling on him or his Lady — why so —
Mr. Broome waits at N. York till my return
or until we hear from — Mr. Scott well
let off for Holland this week with Mrs. G. —
let me know what you have done on
the Business of your Election, & the Hairs off.
Mr. B. — must hear before he starts, another
Step — his Lawyers have soured his Mind —
& I view him to be doubtful —

Mr. Bernard Smith, & Mr. Hunt have called on me
& my Son, with others from Washington —
I have seen Edmund Welles Esqr of Cambridge &
my Letter to him, Mr. Thorn & Mr. Masters will
have full effect — New York is again block-
aded by the British — respects to all. S. Peters

In my letter to D^r B^r of July 12th 1806. After some salutations
&c. I wrote - I have not seen any of ⁷⁷ - since I wrote to you
on the 16 of June but expect Rufus at my House every Day

I am surprised that D^r B^r - should not furnish you with the money for to
to me to go to the distant Heirs. as you know it was agreed it should be sent
on the Saturday after I left New York, that he need not think his impatience
has exceeded mine. I want to know the result - I feel a determination
to promote the claim - if my health permit, and my Debt to Nature do not
interrupt - But I cannot feel willing to do much more upon uncertainty
- If he concludes to give all up tell me so, If he concludes to go on as agreed
I am ready and willing to exert my influence. But money is the sinews of
both War & Peace. and Money is wanting and must be had -
If he will furnish it I shall be glad - But if not I shall look out elsewhere
I have not money myself. But have that which will procure it to
