

Articles of Agreement between the Heirs of Samuel
Harrison Late Chittenden decedent respecting the divis-
ion of the Lands being the Estate of the Late Samuel
Harrison above named (viz) Thomas Pezoo agrees with
his Wife Carinda Pezoo to receive for their part of $\frac{1}{2}$
Estate of the following Lots and to quit claim all their right
and title to the remainder (to wit) one half of the second
division of the original right of Asa Edmonds lying and
being in Philadelphia in the County of Rutland and
State of Vermont the 4th Division of the Right of Sam
Barnard Jr lying and being in Chittenden in the County
and State aforesaid

Lorrey B. Harrison agrees to receive the following described
pieces of Land in Chittenden in the County and State aforesaid
(viz) thirty one acres of the fifth Division of the right of Zadock
Averist twenty five acres of the 4th division of Nathan Rich
and son thirty one acres of the 5th division of Samuel Silley Jr
sixty acres of 5th division of Thomas Rowley

Rebecca and Pamela agree to receive the following Lot of Land
in Philadelphia in the County and State aforesaid
to be equally divided between them (to wit) the whole of
the 2nd Division of the right of John Barret

Joseph R. Harrison agrees to receive the following Lots of
Land in the Towns of Chittenden and Philadelphia
(viz) the first division of ~~Zadock~~ Asa Edmonds
and half of the second Division of Asa Edmonds lying
and being in Philadelphia the 4th Division of Nathl. Ladd
fifty acres of the 4th Division Zadock Averist fifty acres of
the 4th Division of Samuel Silley Jr lying and being in
Chittenden in the County and State of Vermont

Samuel and William H. Harrison agree on their part to
reieve the remainder of the property of said Estate and
quit Claim the the foregoing described Lots to the several
persons to which they are particularly set ~~to~~, and further
more We the Subscribers do by virtue of this agreement
and the foregoing division ~~do~~ forever release ~~quit~~ and
forever quit Claim to each other ^{the} lands Lots of Ground as
described to be each others shares of said ^{Estate} and we hereby Declare
that by virtue of this agreement we have no right or title
interest or claim to any part of the abovesaid Estate except
that part which we have distinctly and severally agreed to
accept of as a full satisfaction for all the interest which
we have in the Estate of our father deceased

Provided however that if any Benefit or interest should ever
arise or accrue from Cavers Mississippi Land then and in
that Case an equal Division of the same shall be made
among the several Subscribers and it is furthermore understood
that the said Samuel and William are to pay all the de
mands now against said Estate
