> Each bronze medallion is boxed with a finely finished display stand and is edgemarked with the hallmark approved by the 1993 Presidential Inaugural Committee.







Official 1993 Presidential Inaugural License Plates

Be part of the 1993 Presidential Inaugural with a set of Official 1993 Presidential Inaugural License Plates. The plates can be displayed from January 1 through March 31, 1993 on any vehicle currently registered in the United States. Each set of two plates is unique and carries your own individualized message.

Orders for numerical license plates must have a four to six digit number greater than 7000. Alphabetical license plates must have a minimum of two characters and no more than six characters.

To display the license plates on your vehicle, you must enclose a copy of your current vehicle registration with your order. An official registration certificate and validation stickers will be returned to you with your plates. The registration certificate and stickers are not required if the license plates will not be displayed on a vehicle.

Disabled plates are available for individuals who currently display disabled plates on their vehicles.

License plates must be ordered by mail with the order form included in this catalog. Your plates will be shipped to you via UPS in late December or early January.


