My dear Jamie

Dad & I were delighted to hear that there is some chance of your coming over to the Old Country next year. We hope if you come that you will spend a large portion of your time with us. You will find Richmond quaint & lovely and excellent for headquarters. It is just half way between London & Edinburgh. We are sorry you cannot see your way to bringing Mabel & Janet. The latter we have always hoped to have some day for a good long visit, & now that we have a home again it is possible on our side. The river of Richmond

I hope you will be able to dispose of your
