
My dear Mr. Smith:

No doubt this will not reach you until your return. I am at Plymouth, Vermont, where I shall be for a few days more, and could go down to New York any time and meet you there. I have an engagement for the 4th of August for over Sunday.

I am glad to see you are in nowise discouraged. I feel sure that your view of the situation is correct.

The Knife and Fork Club wanted me to come to Minneapolis the very last part of September, not to make a political speech, but leaving me free to speak on any subject I desired. Of course, I should discuss some public questions. I do not want to go there if you have any feeling whatever that I might meet with a disagreeable situation. They are very anxious to have me go and are willing to finance my trip.
