WILLIS A. GORMAN, GOVERNOR OF SAID TERRITORY.

To James A. Case Esq., of Ramsey County sends Greeting:

Reposing especial trust and confidence in your prudence, integrity and ability, I have appointed you, the said James A. Case. You are therefore, by these presents, appointed and commissioned Notary Public in and for said Territory.

To Have and to Hold The said office of Notary Public together with all the rights, powers, and emoluments to the said office belonging, or by law in anywise appertaining, until this appointment or commission shall be by me or other lawful authority, superseded or annulled, or expire by force or reason of any law of the United States or of this Territory.

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the Territory,
at St Paul, this 11th day of February in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty ~~sevens~~ and of
the Territory the Eighth.
