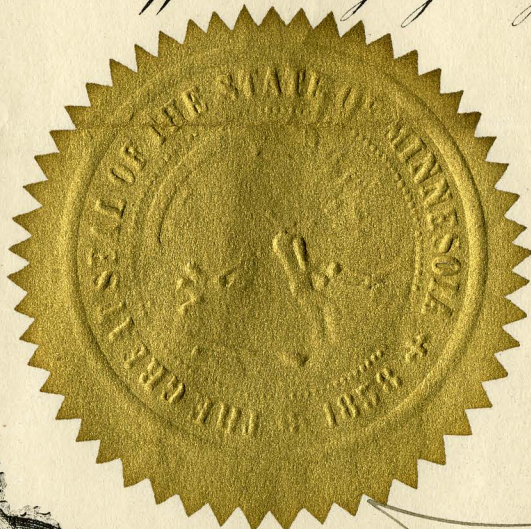


WINFIELD S. HAMMOND, GOVERNOR OF SAID STATE:

To Allyn K. Ford of Hennepin County, Sends Greeting:

Reposing especial trust and confidence in your prudence, integrity and ability, I have appointed you, the said Allyn K. Ford, a NOTARY PUBLIC for the State of Minnesota to reside in Hennepin County for the full term of seven years. You are, therefore, by these presents, appointed and commissioned NOTARY PUBLIC as aforesaid.

To Have and to Hold The said office of NOTARY PUBLIC, together with all the rights, powers and emoluments to the said office belonging, or by law in anywise appertaining, until this commission shall be by me, or other lawful authority, superseded or annulled, or expire by force or reason of any law of this State.
