Dear Mr. and Mrs. Ford:

Thank you for the wire signed by you and others, expressing your opposition to the Bricker Amendment.

The possibility of a treaty taking precedence over our Bill of Rights or other Constitutional safeguards, is a serious question and a definite clarification of this whole matter is advisable at this time. The subject will be thoroughly debated, and I appreciate your views. I want the President to have no more and no less power in this field than he has been considered to have all during our history until recent years.
