MEETING HELD APRIL 18, 2009 AT THE OLD COUNTRY BUFFET IN MAPLEWOOD WITH HOST LORAETTA LOGAN.

16 MEMBERS PRESENT AS FOLLOWS: ANITA ANDERSON, MARGARET BROOKS, LAURIE HANSEN, AJ JACKSON, LORAETTA LOGAN, SHERRIE MAZINGO, DENISE ROGERS, ROSALIND SALTERS, DENNIS SIMS, SONIA STODDARD, PAM STODDARD, SHARON VARNER, INEZ VINER, TONY WILLIAMS, AND PAT WRIGHT. RENEE ELLIS AND CLARICE JOHNSON PHONED INTO THE MEETING.

PRESIDENT AJ JACKSON OPENED THE MEETING AT 12:15 AND CALLED FOR THE MINUTES TO BE READ FROM THE MARCH 21 MEETING. CORRECTIONS TO THE MINUTES INCLUDED:

- 1) THAT IN ADDITION TO THE CLUB SINGING HAPPY BIRTHDAY TO PAT WRIGHT, MEMBERS ALSO SANG HAPPY BIRTHDAY TO MARY WALKER;
- 2) THAT EVERY MEMBER IS TO BRING 3 AUCTION ITEMS TO GAME NIGHT & OTHER APPLICABLE EVENTS, INSTEAD OF A RAFFLE ITEM, AS HAD BEEN READ IN THE MARCH MINUTES.

A LENGTHY DISCUSSION FOLLOWED THAT INCLUDED:

- 1) A CLARIFICATION THAT RAFFLE ITEMS WERE OF HIGHER VALUE AND OF MAJOR BROADER AND GENERAL INTEREST THAN THE INDIVIDUAL RAFFLE ITEMS
- 2) THAT PERHAPS A MEMBER COULD DECIDE IF ONE OR MORE OF THEIR GIFTS WAS TO BE RAFFLE ITEM
- 3) THAT PERHAPS A MEMBER COULD BRING ONE RAFFLE ITEM INSTEAD OF THREE AUCTION ITEMS
- 4) THAT PERHAPS THE RAFFLE TICKETS COULD BE SOLD FOR CASH VALUES, IN OTHER WORDS, RAFFLE OFF MONEY
- 5) THAT PERHAPS THE RAFFLE SHOULD BE ELIMINATED.

THE CLUB SANG HAPPY BIRTHDAY TO RENEE ELLIS AND PAT MANLEY; & ALSO ACKNOWLEDGED JIMMY BUCKNER'S BIRTHDAY IN HIS ABSENCE. IT WAS NOTED THAT JIMMY HAD NOT BEEN FEELING WELL.

REPORT OF THE SOCIAL COMMITTEE: RENEE MADE SEVERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS INCLUDING:

NEXT MONTH—JUNE—IS THE CLUB'S ERMA L. SIMS ANNUAL PICNIC. A DISCUSSION WAS HELD AND EACH MEMBER STATED WHAT ITEM OR ITEMS THAT HE OR SHE WOULD BRING TO THE PICNIC.

A DISCUSSION WAS HELD ON HOW MUCH WE SHOULD SPEND ON RIBS THIS YEAR. AFTER DISCUSSION AND REVIEW, ANITA MOVED TO SPEND \$135 ON RIBS, THE SAME AS LAST YEAR. LORAETTA SECONDED AND THE MOTION PASSED.

FINAL PAYMENT FOR THE WASHINGTON DC TRIP IN JULY IS DUE ON MAY 22

A \$150.00 DEPOSIT FOR THE LAS VEGAS TRIP IN OCTOBER IS DUE MAY 14

A \$100.00 DEPOSIT FOR THE BRANSON TRIP IN NOVEMBER IS DUE JUNE 15

RENEE ALSO DISCUSSED THE CLUB'S 85<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY PLANS INCLUDING THE 7-DAY CRUISE TO THE SOUTH CARIBBEAN, AUGUST 28 - SEPT. 5, 2010. RENEE SAID THAT A \$300 DEPOSIT FOR THE TRIP IS DUE ON JUNE 5.

AGAIN, RENEE ENCOURAGED MEMBERS TO COME UP WIH IDEAS & SUGGESTIONS FOR OTHER EVENTS, ACTIVITIES TO HELP CELEBRATE OUR 20th ANNIVERSARY.

REPORT OF THE HISTORICAL COMMITTEE: SHARON VINER SAID THAT SHE'D LIKE TO PUT TOGETHER A BOOKLET OF CAMEO HISTORY AND BACKGROUND, WHICH WOULD ALSO FEATURE PROFILES OF CURRENT MEMBERS. IN MARCH, WE HAD A BALANCE OF \$2,579.45 WITH TOTAL DEPOSITS OF \$410 AND ONE WITHDRAWAL OF \$60 PAID TO PAT WRIGHT AS REIMBURSEMENT. FOR OVERPAYMENT ON GAME NIGHT TICKETS SOLD.

IN APRIL, WE HAD A BALANCE OF \$1,411.45 WITH TOTAL DEPOSITS OF \$582, AND TOTAL WITHDRAWALS OF \$1,750 INCLUDING \$1,350 IN PAYMENTS FOR GAME NIGHT AND \$400 TO SHARON VARNER TO PURCHASE A CAMERA.

RENEE REPORTED THAT THE CURRENT BALANCE AS OF MAY 15, IS \$3,013.45, INCLUDING A DEPOSIT OF \$1,602, PRINCIPALLY RESULTING FROM GAME NIGHT ACTIVITIES.

DENNIS SIMS ASKED IF MEMBERS COULD HAVE A PRINTED COPY OF THE TREASURER'S REPORT EACH MONTH, OTHER CLUB MEMBERS CONCURRED, AND THE PRESIDENT AND ACTING TREASURER AGREED WITH THIS.

17 MEMBERS WERE PRESENT AS FOLLOWS: ANITA ANDERSON, RENEE ELLIS, LAURIE HANSON, AJ JACKSON, BETTY JONES, LORAETTA LOGAN, PAT MANLEY, SHERRIE MAZINGO, DENNIS SIMS, BERDETTE SMITH, PAM STODDARD, SONIA STODDARD, SHARON VARNER, INEZ VINER, MARY WALKER, TONY WILLIAMS, AND PAT WRIGHT.

PRESIDENT AJ JACKSON OPENED THE MEETING AT 1:15 PM WITH A PEP TALK, A REFRESHER TALK ABOUT THE CLUB'S ROOTS, OUR FOUNDING PURPOSE, AND OVERALL BOND. SHE SPOKE OF THE "UNDERLYING LOVE THAT KEEPS OUR CLUB TOGETHER."






