





CLUB HISTORY

Out of a need for a more active social, cultural and civic life, five teenagers met in the home of Anita Roberts, 978 St. Anthony Avenue, Tuesday, September 4, 1925, to organize a club... this was the birth of the CAMEO SOCIAL CLUB. The group first chose the name 'Birds of Paradise' from a then current Hawaiian play. Officers elected were: Cynthia Hitt, now Mrs. Herbert F. Foster, Sr., president; Anita Roberts, now Mrs. Melvin Thomas of Berkeley, California, vice-president; Esther Bradley, now Estyr Bradley Peake of St. Paul, secretary; Audrey Boswell, now Mrs. Winifred Jones, a Los Angeles attorney, treasurer; Guinevere Kelly, later Gwen Kelly Twiggs, now deceased, Critic.

In those days no self-respecting group of teenagers were without a supervisor, chaperone or advisor. Mrs. Annabelle Hitt Holiday, now Mrs. James Rideaux of St. Paul, sister of Cynthia, was asked to fill this role. She agreed on the condition that the name be changed to the Cameo Club.

"We met weekly and collected 10¢ dues from each member. Cynthia was the "belle" and we just couldn't keep Herbert Foster away from the meetings, "notes the club history. Herbert brought George Brooks, Jr. with him to the meetings and on September 22, 1925, Herbert was admitted as a member, George Brooks on October 6, 1925, and was followed closely in October of that year by Edward Griffin, now deceased, Artie Boyd, now of Los Angeles, Cal., Leroy Lazenberry and Peter Robinson of St. Paul.

The first social event for the Cameo Club was an "Introductory Ball" on November 6, 1925, in the home of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Bradley, Sr., 934 St. Anthony Ave., parents of Esther.

A love story is woven into Cameo history. Cynthia and Herbert were married, January 4, 1926, and on January 4, 1976, will celebrate their Golden Wedding anniversary in the home of Annabelle Hitt Rideaux and her husband, James.

Cameo Social Club always had a full agenda a party at Christmas vacation, a Spring dance, hayrides, picnics, pow-wows and roller skating parties in the summer, ice skating, bob sled and sleigh ride parties in the winter . . . On the cultural side, there were Sunday afternoon Forums at the Central Avenue Branch of the YWCA, 598 W. Central avenue, of which Miss Helen Hudson, now Mrs. Green of Los Angeles, was the Executive Director. Christian Endeavor and Young People's meetings at St. James A. M. E. and Pilgrim Baptist churches On the Civic side, contributions were made to the Community Chest, Red Cross, Y.W.C.A., etc., Thanksgiving baskets and Christmas toys were distributed to those less fortunate.

In those early year's, Cameo Club produced plays, dance revues and concerts with the late Freda Jackson DeKnight, now deceased, and Gladys Harris Freeman, now of Indianapolis, Indiana, as early directors.

An early member, Frank Wright, was a part of a farm family in Robbinsdale, Minnesota. His parents opened their home and grounds to the Cameo's for pow-wows, hay rides, sleigh rides, etc.

Our first chaperones were three couples, the late Dr. and Mrs. J. Walton Crump, Attorney and Mrs. George Hamilton, Dr. Earl S. Weber of 880 Concordia avenue (formerly Rondo) and his first wife, Mrs. Lucille Elliott Inge, now living in Hampton, Virginia.

Outstanding among Cameo Social events was one of the annual November dances held at Union Hall, Kent and Aurora, and a Fancy Dress ball at Keller Golf Club. During those early years, Cameos had their own orchestra... Edward Byron Doty, George W. Brooks, Jr., Albert Patrick, Peter Robinson, Rudolph Martin, Also, their own news columnist, Estyr, who began writing for a local Negro weekly paper two years after the club was organized.

Cameos gave their first Cotillion Ball in 1956 where Debutantes were presented from the Twin Cities and out of state cities. Regular programs and gifts were taken to the Crispus Attucks Home for the Aged.

Ten years ago, the Cameo Club held its 40th birthday party at the St. Paul Hilton Hotel. Associate members came from several states, including charter member, Audrey Boswell Jones.

The Club is a Lifetime member of the NAACP.

The motto those five girls chose for the Cameo Social Club that evening in 1925 is still meaningful today:

"Down not the one who is down, Cheer them up in their sorrow, For this old world is a funny old world, And you may be down tomorrow."



Fifty years in numbers seems like a long, long time but is it when you take time to reflect on the good times we have had together as CAMEOS, all of the beautiful people we have met along the way, the friendships we've made, which we always will treasure, and the contribution we have made to life in this community.

As President of the Cameo Social Club on our Golden Anniversary, I want to welcome our friends and patrons, our Associate members and other out of town guests, and our souvenir booklet advertisers for making this occasion a memorable one.
