

You perhaps recall that, when you were discussing the Diesel electric shop for Auburn a few days ago, the question of store facilities was raised and Mr. Turner told you that in his opinion separate ones were not necessary in the new shop building as they would require constant attendance at an expense of about \$4,000 per year. He further stated that extending the existing facilities at an estimated expense of around \$20,000 would take care of what will be necessary. Mr. Grimm agreed to the arrangement.

The Diesel shop is being laid out without a store room and I have asked Mr. Blum to arrange for extending the present store house in accordance with the plan which Mr. Turner has recommended. The work is to be handled as a portion of the shop job if it will work out to advantage.
