On behalf of the

ask you for instructions as to what we
would have to do to enable us to
obtain pension - we were wounded
during the Indian out-break on Aug 23
1862. and partially crippled by shot
wounds during the fight - we were
sworn in as militia by the Sheriff, and
I would think under the Law last passed
we would be included. I have also
mentioned the widows & orphans -
Hoping to receive a favorable reply I
