You are, therefore, carefully and diligently to discharge the Duty of a Lieutenand in leading, ordering, and exercifing the faid Company in Arms, both inferior Officers, and Soldiers, and to keep them in good Order and Discipline; and they are hereby commanded to obey you as their Lieutenants and you are yourself to observe and follow such Orders and Instructions as you shall, from Time to Time, receive from the General and Commander in Chief of the Forces raifed in the Colony aforefaid, for the Defence of the same, or any other your superior Officers, according to military Rules and
