

Loston Harris




Loston Harris, whose debut album, "Comes Love" earned him a nomination for Best Vocalist of The Year with the Soul Train Awards, has some serious jazz chops tempered by a silky voice more reminiscent of Nat King Cole.

In a cover story in the Washington Post Sunday Magazine, his new style was heralded as "hip suburban cool," a mixture of the romantic old-school jazz and Loston's own modern stylings. He never forgets his roots—delving into gospel, New Orleans-style jazz, and Ellington influences all in one show—but it's his voice that mesmerizes much of his audience.

A prolific composer, his shows are punctuated with humor and romantic ballads; fast-tempo swing tunes and blues.

Tonight's performance also features Marcus Parsley on trumpet; Jeff Hanley on bass; and Leon Anderson on percussion.
