





WASHINGTON, D.C. — Benning today, airlines will no nger be required to ask pasngers security questions out whether they have kept a use eye on their baggage.

Ticket agents have been retired for 16 years to ask pasngers: "Has anyone untown to you asked you to caran item on this flight?" and lave any of the items you are tiveling with been out of your mediate control since the ne you packed them?"

The questions are being ased out because they are a sisle and have never preventla bombing or hijacking, mes Loy, head of the Transtration Security Administration (TSA), said Wednesday, wer the years, they have lost natever original value they ntributed and can now be fely eliminated."

The questions take about 20 conds to ask and that adds to ssengers' wait in line, Loy id. Airlines are "delighted" at a decision, he said.

David Stempler, president the Air Travelers Associan, said passengers would be lighted, too. "It's about
