DAYTON'S FALL OVAL ROOM SHOW TO FEATURE CHANEL COLLECTION

Dayton's Oval Room fashion show on Wednesday, September 10, in Dayton's Minneapolis store will feature the fall collection from Chanel. The show benefits the Friends of the Institute, which provides support for the Minneapolis Institute of Arts programs such as school tours, weekend family events and teaching exhibitions.

The House of Chanel continues to be one of the most acclaimed fashion houses in the world due to the design talent of Karl Lagerfeld. Since taking over as designer for Chanel in 1983 Lagerfeld has continued to interpret the classic style created by its founder Gabrielle "Coco" Chanel.

The evening will begin with a reception in Dayton's auditorium followed by the fashion show and dinner. Tickets are available by calling the Friends of the Institute office at 870-3045. Benefactor tickets are \$125 and include a private reception beginning at 5:30 p.m. in Dayton's Gallery 12. THE CHANEL STORY

Gabrielle Chanel, "Coco" to her friends, was a designer, business executive, socialite, and supporter of the arts. But the one thing she loved most of all was her work. She began her career by designing hats for friends after her move to Paris in 1909. By 1913, she had opened her first fashion boutique in Deauville, where she began a design revolution based on her philosophy of "freedom of movement." Chanel cut her first garments of Rodier jersey. With their loose-fitting, less structured forms and unique fluidity, Chanel introduced women to sportswear.

In 1954 Chanel came out of retirement and introduced a fresh new look that became a cultural reference of our time: suits with bordered jackets and gold buttons, quilted handbags with gold chains, and beige shoes with dark tips. Gabrielle Chanel died in 1971, just a few days before the triumph of her final collection.

In 1983, Karl Lagerfeld assumed responsibility for the HOUSE OF **CHANEL**'s fashion design. An award-winning designer in his own right, Mr. Lagerfeld successfully combined his modern vision and the signature style of Coco Chanel. Under his aegis, the HOUSE OF **CHANEL** has thrived, ensuring that the **CHANEL** name will remain a living symbol of French elegance.




