DAYTON'S SPRING OVAL ROOM SHOW PRESENTS DIVERSE OFFERINGS

Spring 1990 evokes the themes of Earth and Heaven, as Dayton's Oval Room presents its spring designer collections on Wednesday, Feb. 28 and Thursday, March 1. In recognition of a heightened concern for the environment, the show will benefit the North Star Chapter of the Sierra Club. And in keeping with the themes of the season, Dayton's Minneapolis eighth-floor auditorium will provide an environmental backdrop suggestive of both the forests of South America and the hidden glens of the muses.

Myron Johnson, artistic director of Minneapolis based dance-theater company Ballet of the Dolls, is directing and choreographing the Oval Room show. Johnson, with the assistance of approximately 40 models and 15 dancers, will theatrically move the show through its inspirations of Peru, Africa, Mexico, and the Southwest, eventually progressing into the fluidity of the Heavens. Designs from Callaghan, based on the peasant look, and Missoni, with its mixed brights of the fiesta, will be shown, as will Claude Montana's African tribal-influenced, earth-toned pieces in gold, rust and bronze. Issey Miyake's spring collection introduces a combination of wearable pleated workshirts and denims.

Ralph Lauren offers two primary themes for spring. One focuses on the colors of red, white and navy, with military-inspired jackets braided in gold, while the other reflects a French overtone, featuring poor boy sweaters, shorter skirts and berets.

The collections of Calvin Klein and Donna Karan for spring '90 focus on beautifully understated, softly tailored and fluid clothing. Calvin Klein features primarily pant silhouettes in neutral palettes, while Donna Karan is a bit dressier, offering more skirts and dresses, also in neutrals.

The final segment of the show, featuring the Heavenly-inspired or New Age collections, will include the designs of Jean Paul Gaultier and Workers for Freedom, as well as the exciting spring offerings of Rifat Ozbek. Ozbek's designs are all in white, whether in sequins, terry or wool. His collection communicates a peacefulness of the soul, a kind of nirvana. His purity of style and elegant simplicity won accolades from the fashion press during the spring preview of his line. Dayton's offers Ozbek's designs exclusively in Minneapolis.

The evening show on Wednesday, Feb. 28, will be preceded by a light dinner at 6:30 p.m. Tickets are \$40 (\$25 tax deductible). On Thursday, March 1, a luncheon show will be held at 11:30 a.m. Tickets for the noon show, which include a box lunch, are \$30 (\$21 tax deductible) for reserved and \$20 (\$11 tax deductible) for general seating. 

Missoni

Rosita and Tai Missoni celebrate vibrant color with pattern mixes of checkerboards and confetti patchwork all in a Caribbean flavor.

Issey Miyake

Tokyo designer Issey Miyake continues his revolutionary process of pleating the finished garment, rather than the fabric. This season's "Westward" interpretation presents cowboy pleats accented with bandanas.

Ralph Lauren

Ralph Lauren's collection salutes the north and south of France. The French military theme is based on officer's jackets complete with gold braid. The seafaring pants and striped sailor sweaters were inspired by Deauville.

Calvin Klein

Calvin Klein's collection focuses on soft tailoring with uncomplicated and sophisticated silhouettes. Beige becomes a primary color in shades of blond, wheat, sand, and khaki, with quiet styling for the 90's.

Laura Marolakos

Simple evening dresses which curve with the body are Laura's forte. The collection, often touched with lace, speaks of a young elegance.

Jean Paul Gaultier

The Gaultier collection symbolizes the new spirituality surfacing in fashion, with an emphasis on white as healing and restoring inner peace. The cage jackets, constructed of covered wires, boning, and laces, parallel the deconstructivist movement in architecture, glorifying the architecture of fashion.

Workers for Freedom

The British design duo of Richard Nott and Graham Fraser received this year's Designer of the Year award presented by Princess Diana in London. This collection was inspired by the Walker Sculpture Garden, and is based on attitudes of dressing for the new decade.

Ozbek

The shimmering white collection of Rifat Ozbek of London embodies the new age movement away from the materialism of the 80's to the transformed caring global citizen of the 90's. He presents a message for the mind as well as the body with symbols of Yin, Yang and Zen, proclaiming the purity and simplicity of the new decade.
